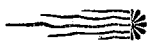
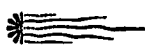

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HAMILTON.



HAMILTON, the second city of the Province of Ontario, is situated on the south shore of Hamilton (formerly Burlington) bay, the western extremity of lake Ontario. It lies just east of the 80th degree of longitude, and just north of the 43rd parallel of latitude.

Hamilton occupies an alluvial plain lying between the bay and the escarpment which forms the outer rim of the lake basin. This escarpment—locally known as “the mountain”—is the height over which the Niagara plunges at the Falls. From its summit a magnificent view may be had. The city lies immediately below, the squares in the centre as distinct as those of a chess board, while in other parts the luxuriant maples with which the streets are lined almost hide the dwellings from sight. The broad blue waters of Lake Ontario stretch away to the eastern horizon. To the northward the view is closed in by a continuation of the height on which the observer stands. The plain is covered in all directions with fruitful farms and dotted with thriving villages. The spires of Toronto may be dimly discerned on the north side of the lake, forty miles away; and on a clear day the smoke of Niagara, at about the same distance, may sometimes be seen.

At the opening of the present century the ground on which Hamilton now stands was covered with forest. A dozen years later it was occupied by farmers, and gradually a hamlet grew up at the spot which is now the centre of the city, but it was not until 1833 that a municipal organization was effected. In 1836, just fifty-six years ago, the inhabitants numbered 2,846, and the assessed value of property was less than \$175,000. Ten years later the population was found to be nearly 7,000, and a city charter was obtained. The population at present is upwards of 50,000.

Hamilton is in direct railway communication with all parts of the Province, while she has by the great lakes and rivers water communication from Chicago, Duluth and Sault Ste. Marie at the west to the Atlantic seaboard.

There are in Hamilton 9,951 houses, 4,975 of which are brick, 530 stone and 4,446 frame. The area of the city is 3,696 acres. There are ninety and a quarter miles of streets, forty miles of sewers, ninety and three-tenths miles of water mains and thirty-five and a half acres of public parks.

The city is represented by two members in the Dominion Parliament and by one in the Ontario Legislature. It has three daily newspapers. Its local affairs are managed by a city council composed of a mayor and twenty-one Aldermen. It is amply supplied with excellent water from Lake Ontario.

A police force of fifty men is found ample to preserve the peace ; and a highly efficient fire department has been able to save the city from serious loss by fire. The streets are lighted by electric lamps. It is no exaggeration to say that in all material interests Hamilton is now more prosperous and its progress more rapid than at any former period.

No other Canadian city has won for itself the industrial celebrity that Hamilton has attained. The city is often called the Birmingham of Canada, and though comparison with the world's great workshop in the English midlands is presumptuous, it is not altogether unwarranted. A place, within the memory of living men transformed from the wilds of a forest, can necessarily in but few things be compared with Birmingham. In one point, however, such a comparison may not be unseemly. Hamilton resembles the larger and older hive of industry in her thrifty application of skill and capital to widely diversified industrial operations. This has been her distinguishing characteristic for at least a generation. Within that period, manufacturing establishments on a scale and with equipments in keeping with the latest demands for cheap and efficient production, have successively sprung up within her limits. Her increasing workshops have steadily added to her population and enhanced her wealth. Scarcely an important branch of industry is left altogether unrepresented. A statement of the industrial progress of Hamilton as extracted from the census returns shows that the total capital invested in manufacturing industries in the ambitious city on April 6 last was \$8,012,000, against \$485,500 ten years ago. The number of employes has increased from 3,100 to 9,575, the total amount of wages paid last year was \$3,203 500 ; the average for employe per annum being \$335, as against \$355 in Toronto and \$331 in Montreal. The total value of the products in the year was \$13,980,000, as against \$8,210,000 in 1881. The value of the products per head of population has increased 25 per cent in the ten years.

Her factories, equipped with modern machinery and the latest labor-saving devices to minimize the cost of production maintain a daily output of innumerable articles of the metal, wood and leather industries, of textile fabrics and of glassware, pottery, clothing, etc. The curing and packing of meats, and canning of fruits and vegetables are also carried on in accordance with advantageous methods peculiar to the western side of the Atlantic.

A careful perusal of the miscellaneous directory in this book will give the reader a better idea of the educational, municipal, social, religious and benevolent institutions, etc., than could be mentioned here. The classified directory also shows faithfully the professional, mercantile and manufacturing establishments of the city.

Hamilton is distant 40 miles from Toronto ; St. Catherines, 31 ; London 75 ; Detroit, 186 ; Kingston, 200 ; Montreal, 373 ; Quebec, 538.

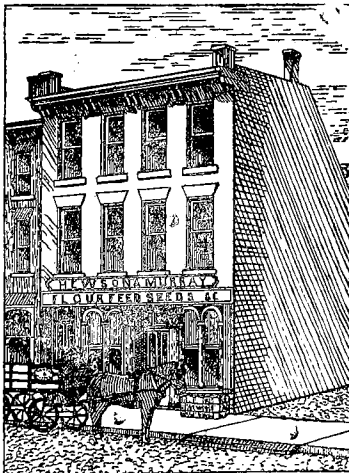

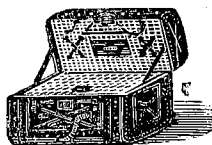

The schools in this district are: The Central school and the Main street school

District III, or Ryerson school district, including that part of Ward 3 being west of a line passing along Caroline, Hunter and James sts; head master, Walter H Davis. The schools in this district are: The Ryerson, Hannah st, Mountain ave and Girls' Home

District IV, or Hess st school district, includes Ward 4; head

master, A S Cruickshank. The schools in this district are; Hess st, Murray st, Market st and Pearl st schools

District V, or Cannon st school district, includes Ward 5 and Ward 6 west of Ferguson ave; head master, T L Kinrade. The schools in this district are: Cannon st, Picton st, Mary st and Hughson st schools

District VI, or Victoria school district, includes Ward 7 and Ward 6 east of Ferguson ave; head master, John Ross. The schools in this district are: Victoria ave, West ave, Wentworth st, Wellington st and Sherman ave schools

There are 23 schools, 160 teachers, and a regular attendance of over 7000 pupils
