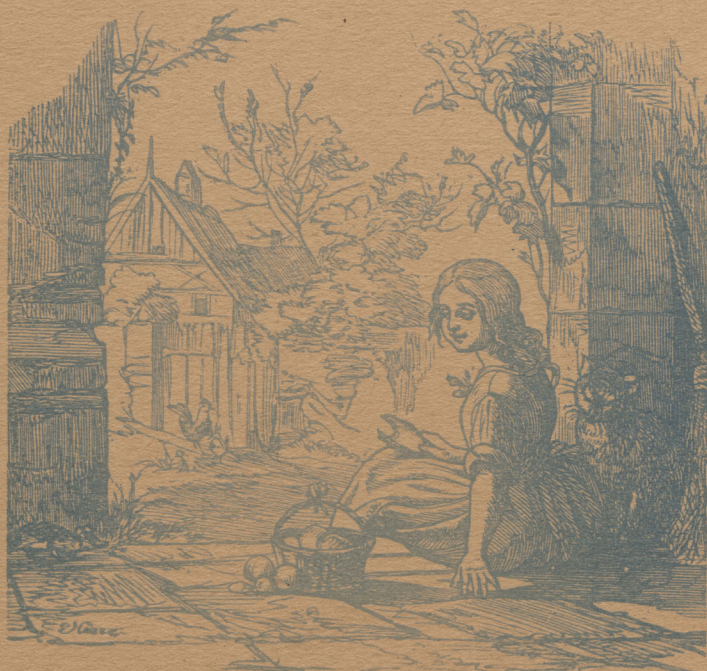
The Greyhound, who looks to see if he can find a Stag.

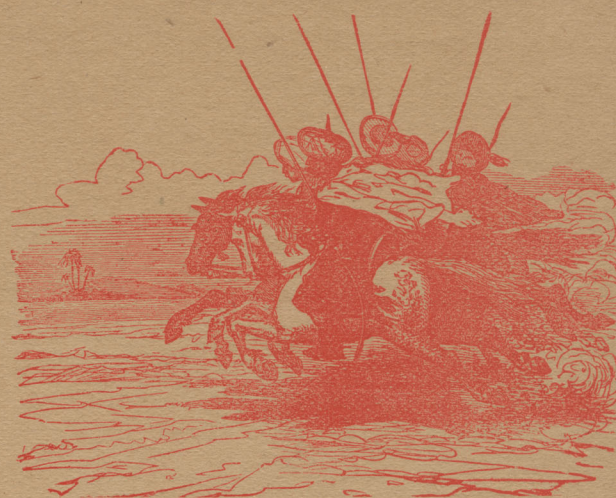

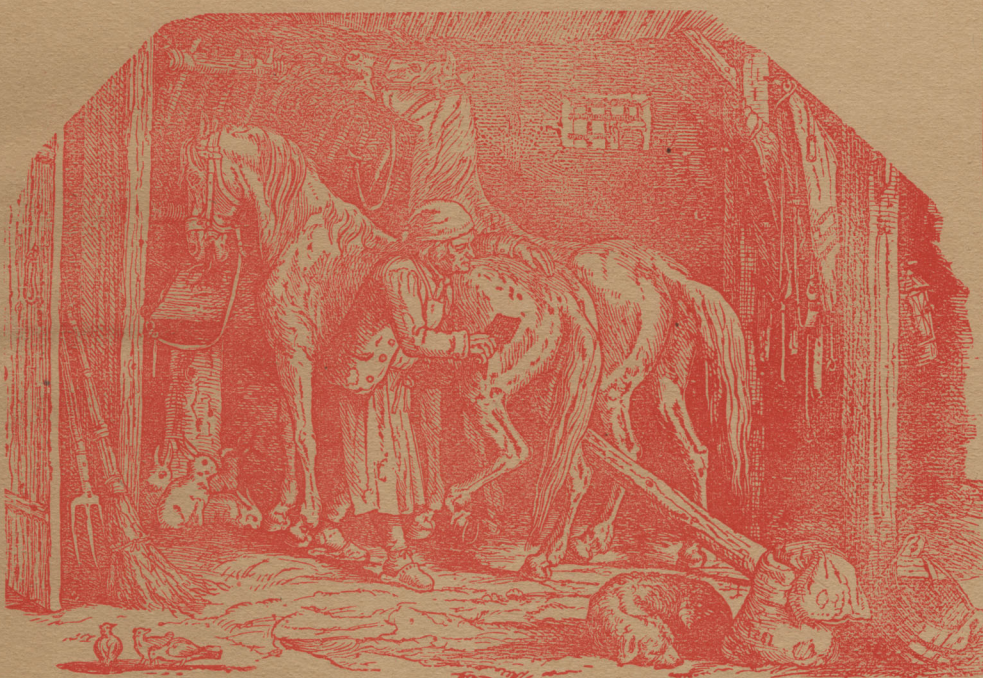

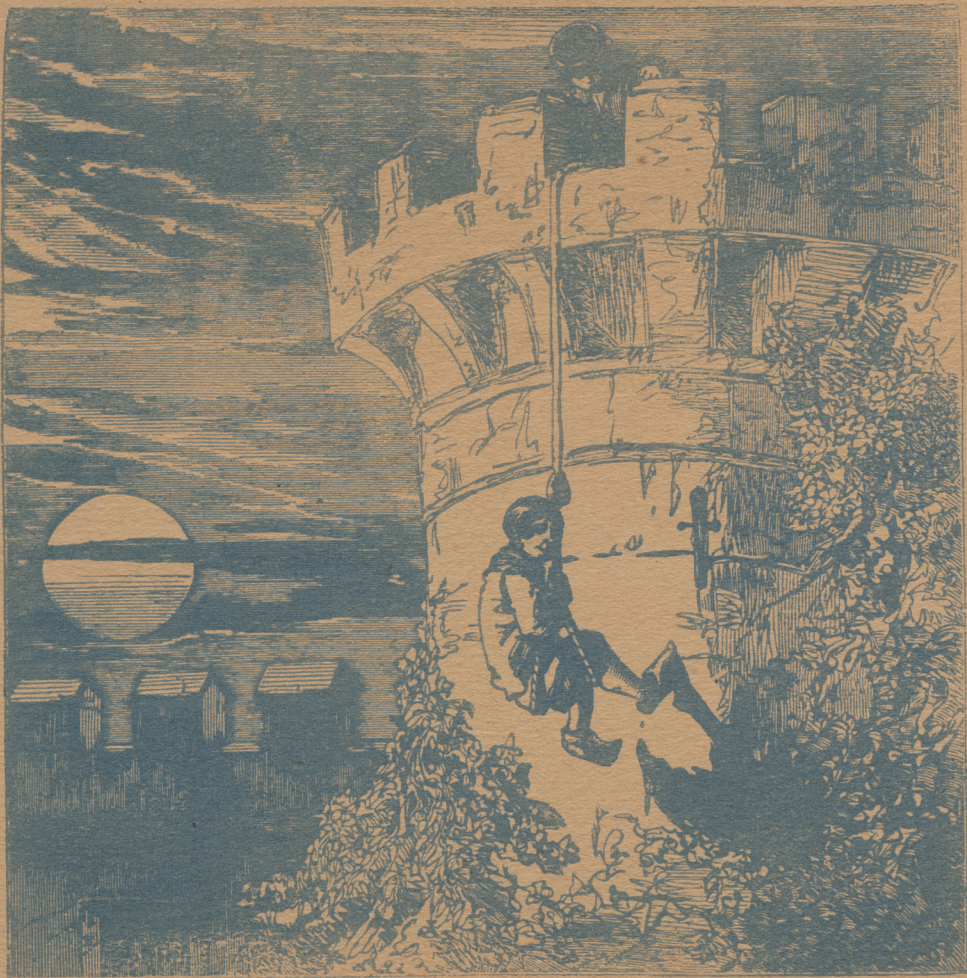

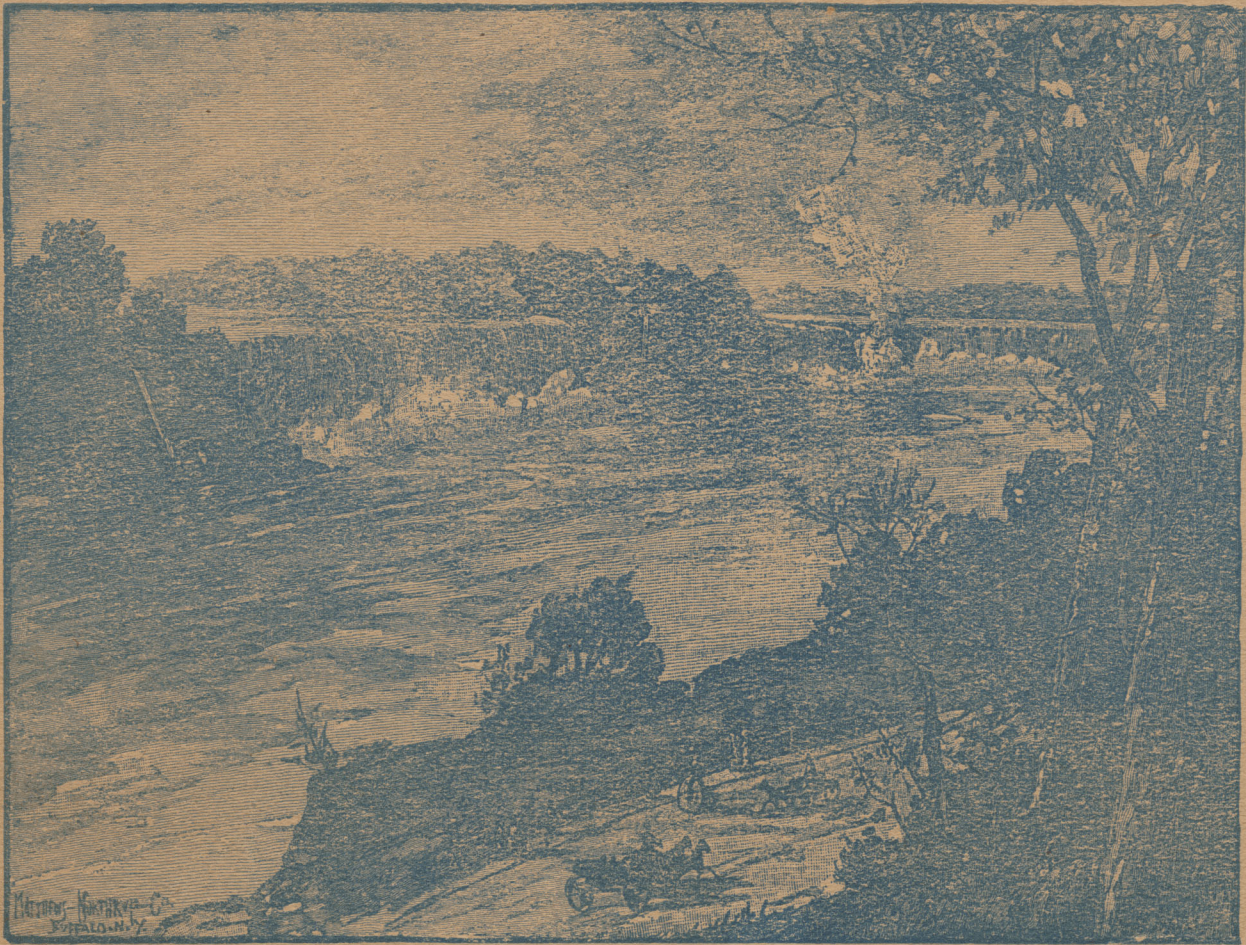
