Eatonia Hubs, Fig. 1, illustrates rear hub with detachable rear sprocket and lock nut used on our Eatonia bicycles. The hubs are turned from drop forged tool steel, are light, properly made and very strong.

Eatonia Chain Adjustment, Fig. 2, illustrates the Eatonia chain adjustment, simple, effective and strong. No difficulty in getting and keeping rear wheel centered between the forks.

Eatonia Chain. 4-inch Indianapolis is used on all Eatonia bicycles, ensuring strength and durability.

Eatonia Sprocket Wheels are both drop forged and nickel-plated, with the teeth properly cut to fit chain, and perfectly fastened to axle and hubs, ensuring strength and ease of running.

Eatonia Dust-Proof Ball-Bearings. Large balls are used,  $\frac{1}{16}$  in bracket and  $\frac{1}{16}$  in rear and front hubs are used, detachable bearing cases, made of specially hardened steel, are fitted in hubs and bottom brackets. All Eatonia wheels run easy because of perfect bearings, rigid frame, and true sprockets.

Eatonia Cones are made of best drop-forged tool steel, carefully made, accurately true and properly hardened. They withstand wear and will not break. They fit properly within bearing cases and flush with outside of hubs and bracket, making the bearings almost absolutely dust proof.

Eatonia Bottom Brackets. The bottom brackets are made of dropforged steel, large size, with perfectly fitting detachable bearing cases, and properly fitting cones and large ball-bearings.

The Tread in Models A and B is 5 inches, in C and D, 4½ inches. Models C and D have also a special one-piece crank and axle, with a detachable sprocket wheel.

Eatonia Frame. Special attention has been given to the construction of the frames for Eatonia bicycles. Only the best cold drawn, seamless steel tubing is used. All joints are drop-forgings, carefully brazed to tubing and properly re-inforced. The rear forks and back stays are thoroughly braced, making the frame very strong, capable of standing severe strains, and rigid enough to carry the heaviest rider without springing out of true. To the strength and rigidity of the frame is due, to a large extent, the success and easy running of Eatonia bicycles.

Parts for Eatonia Bicycles. All parts of Eatonia bicycles are interchangeable, and if lost or broken may be replaced. We keep these parts always in stock and supply them to riders of our wheels at their exact cost to us. No trouble about replacing broken parts of Eatonia bicycles. 

It is the most valuable improvement since the introduction of the pneumatic tires. It adds stiffness to the frame and crank-shaft. Admits of the narrowest possible tread. The Large Barrel Hubs and Large Crank-Shaft Bracket first introduced in Columbias, adds to the ease of running, lightness and strength of the machine. Large balls make the bearings run with exceeding smoothness, and direct oiling is secured by oil holes immediately over the ball races.



The Hartford Single Tube Tire forms the regular equipment of Columbia bicycles. This tire excels in speed, durability and ease to repair, and gives less annoyance and expense than any other.
