REPORT OF THE CHAIRMAN OF THE PUBLIC LIBRARY BOARD FOR THE YEAR 1905.

Gentlemen:

By the statistical tables which follow, it will be seen that there has been a slight decrease in the number of books issued for home reading. This result is partly due to the comparatively small number of people out of employment and the consequently increased number of those who have money to spend on the ordinary amusements of the day. In prosperous years other methods of passing the time appear to be preferred to the reading of books.

However, an analysis of the total issues of the Central and Branch Libraries shows some interesting facts. The number of books lent for reading at home in 1905 was 352,061 or 12,072 less than that during 1904, but this falling off is almost entirely confined to Periodicals and works of Fiction. On the other hand there is in almost all other classes a healthy increase. In the Natural Sciences the advance is 14 per cent., in Political and Moral Sciences, 7 per cent., in the Mechanical Arts $7\frac{1}{2}$ per cent., while Geography and Travel, History, Biography and French Literature all show considerable gains. The number of tickets granted during the past year is larger by 208 than that of the previous year and the fines show an increase of \$49.83 for the same period. During the winter months the Newspaper Reading rooms were filled to their utmost capacity, constant and close attention being required to preserve order.

An examination of candidates for the position of Assistants in the Library was held on April 26th. Of those who presented themselves only five attained the required standard.

Some years ago the Chief Librarian called the attention of the Board to the difficulty of providing accommodation for the books. In the past year this question of shelf-room became a

serious problem, and during the period which must elapse before the new building is ready, much inconvenience to the public will arise.

In May, the Chairman of the Building Committee, the Chief Librarian and the City Architect visited some of the larger cities in the Eastern United States, for the purpose of inspecting the most important library buildings. They reported that they had been received with the utmost kindness, that every opportunity had been afforded them of making the required investigation and that they had collected much valuable information.

During the months of June and July the Chief Librarian and the City Architect prepared a programme of the requirements for the plans of the new Reference Library.

The City Council at the end of September signified their concurrence in the programme and it was at once printed and distributed to the architects of the Dominion. January 31st, 1906, will be the last day for the reception of the plans, a date which leaves ample room for the preparation of the detailed plans and the letting of contracts before the approaching summer.

In December last the Board received permission to proceed with the erection of a Branch Library on the lot east of the Fire Hall, Yorkville Avenue, to take the place of that which has been so unfortunately situated in St. Paul's Hall. For this building the City Architect and the Chief Librarian have undertaken to prepare plans which will be laid before you at an early date.

The Chief Librarian, the Secretary-Treasurer and the Assistants have during the past year faithfully and efficiently performed the duties of their respective offices.

I have to thank the Members of the Board and the two chief officers for the courteous assistance which they have rendered to me during the year.
