

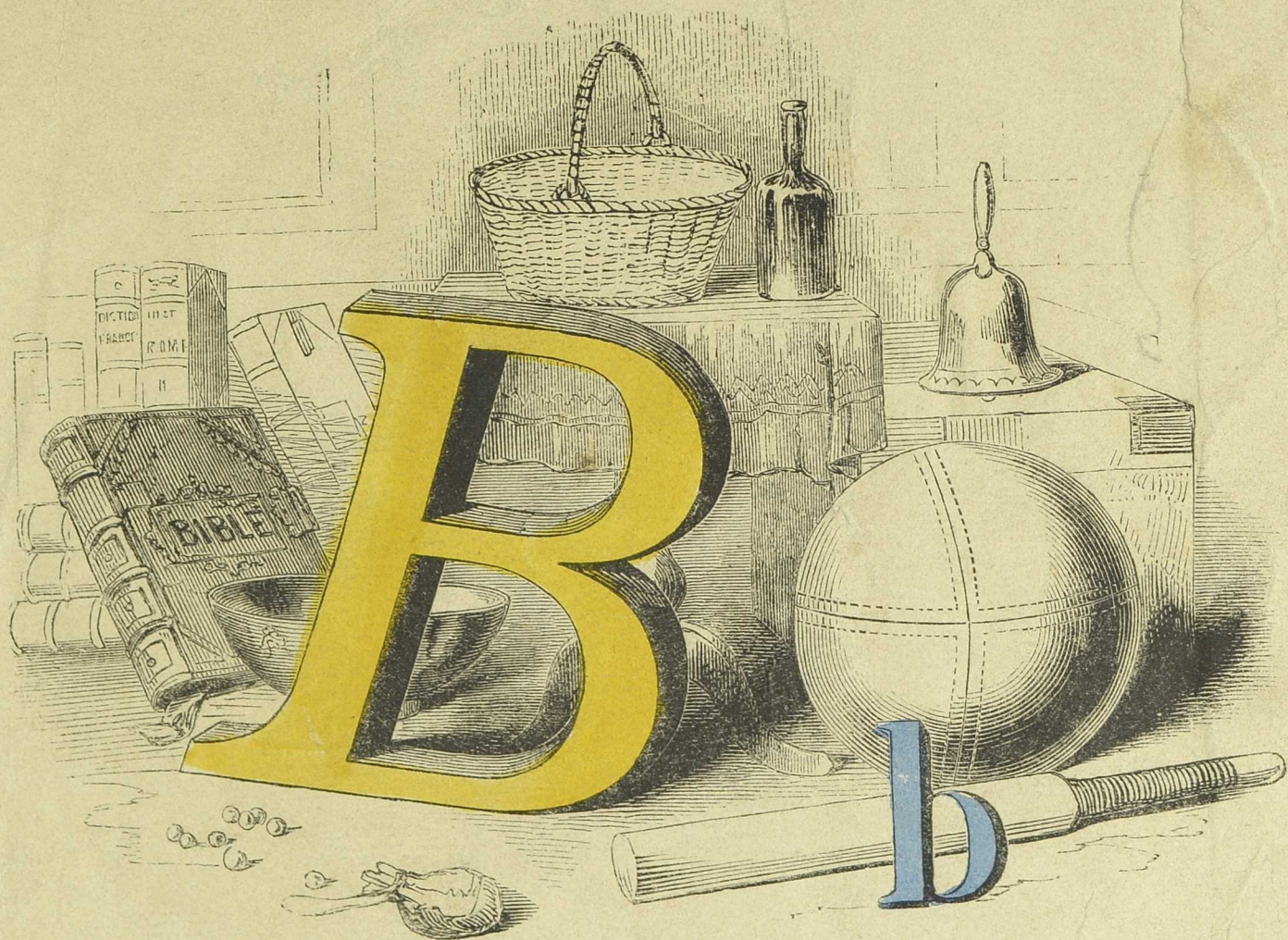

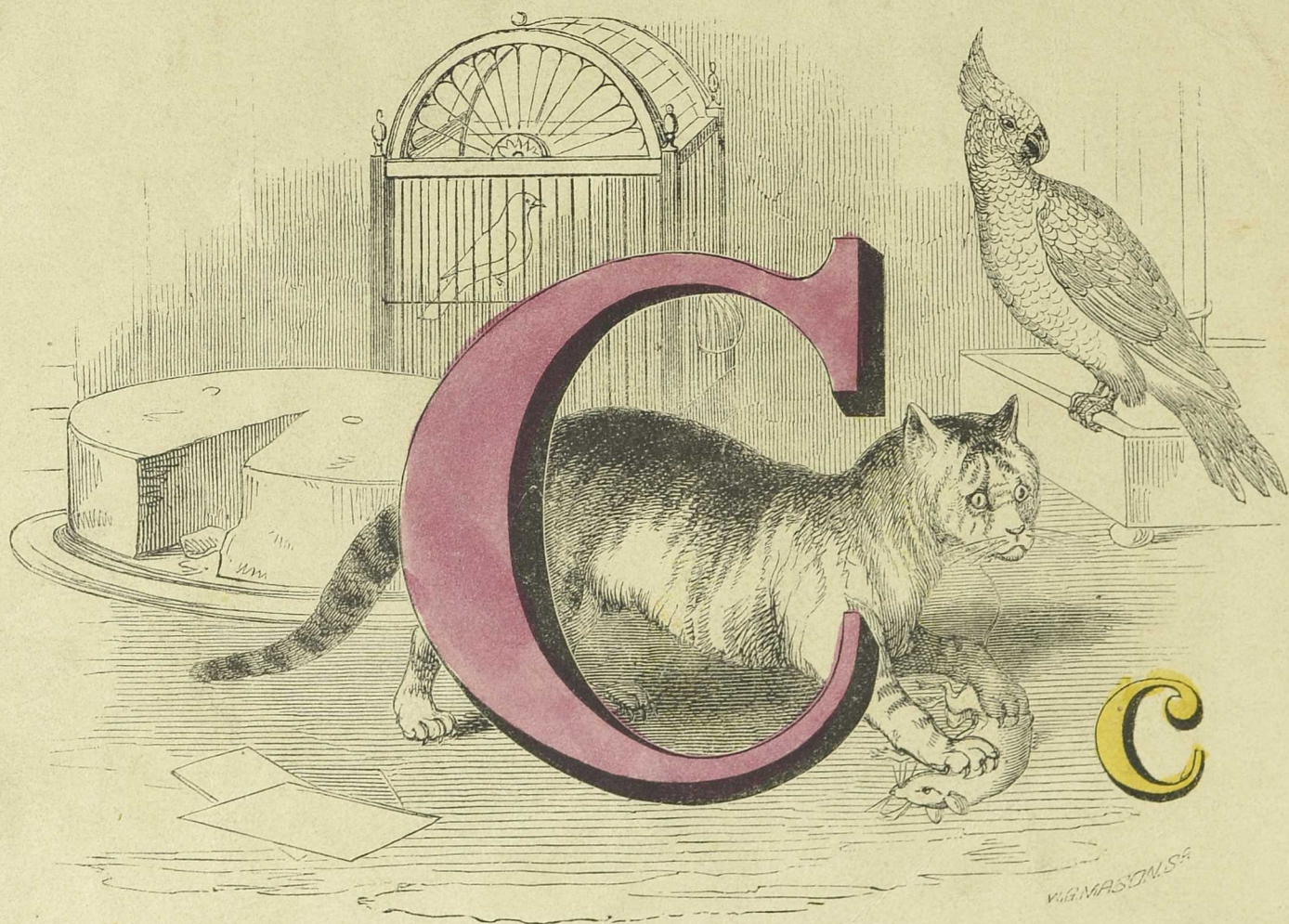

sits up.



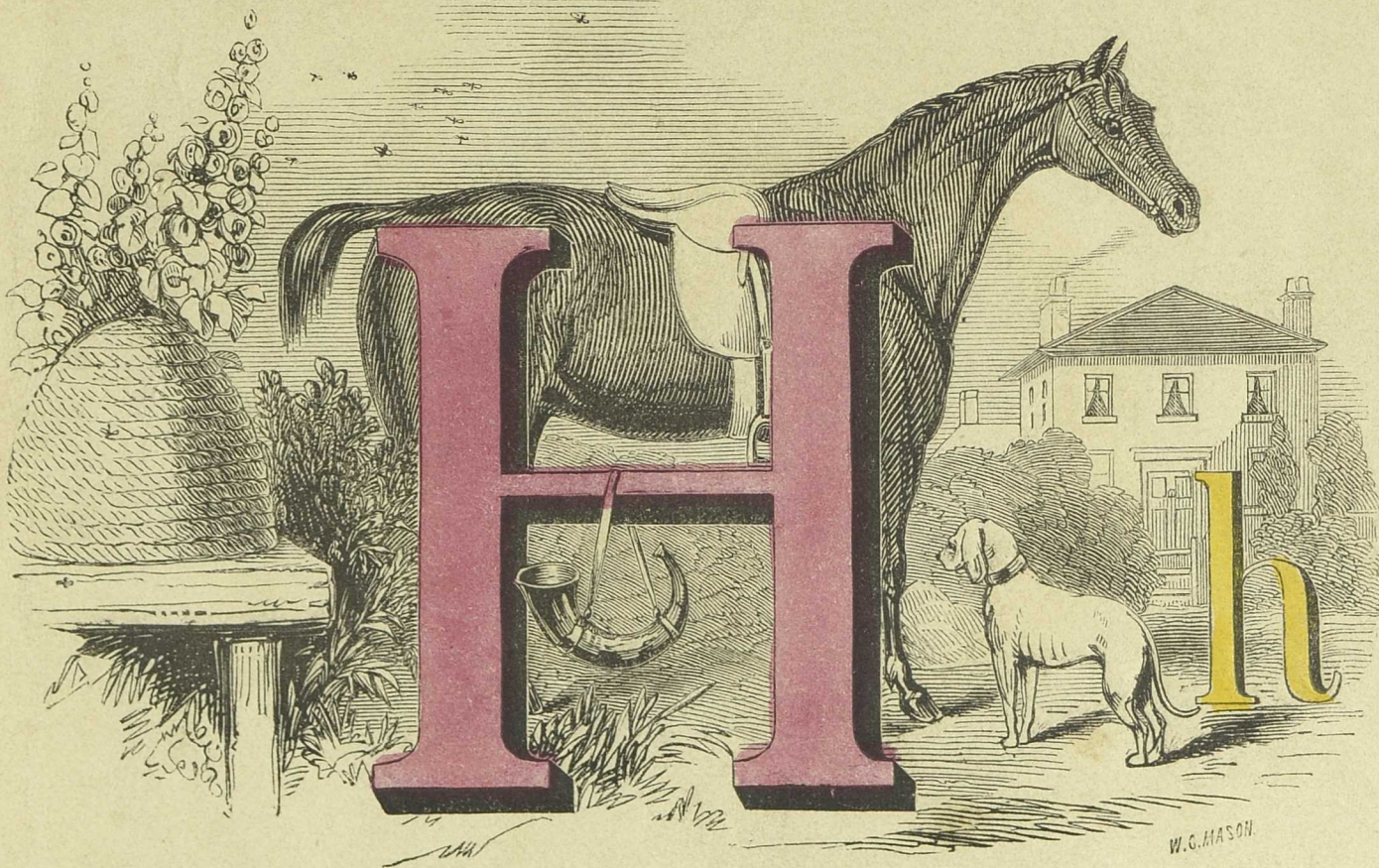
E is for Elephant, mon-
strous and high.



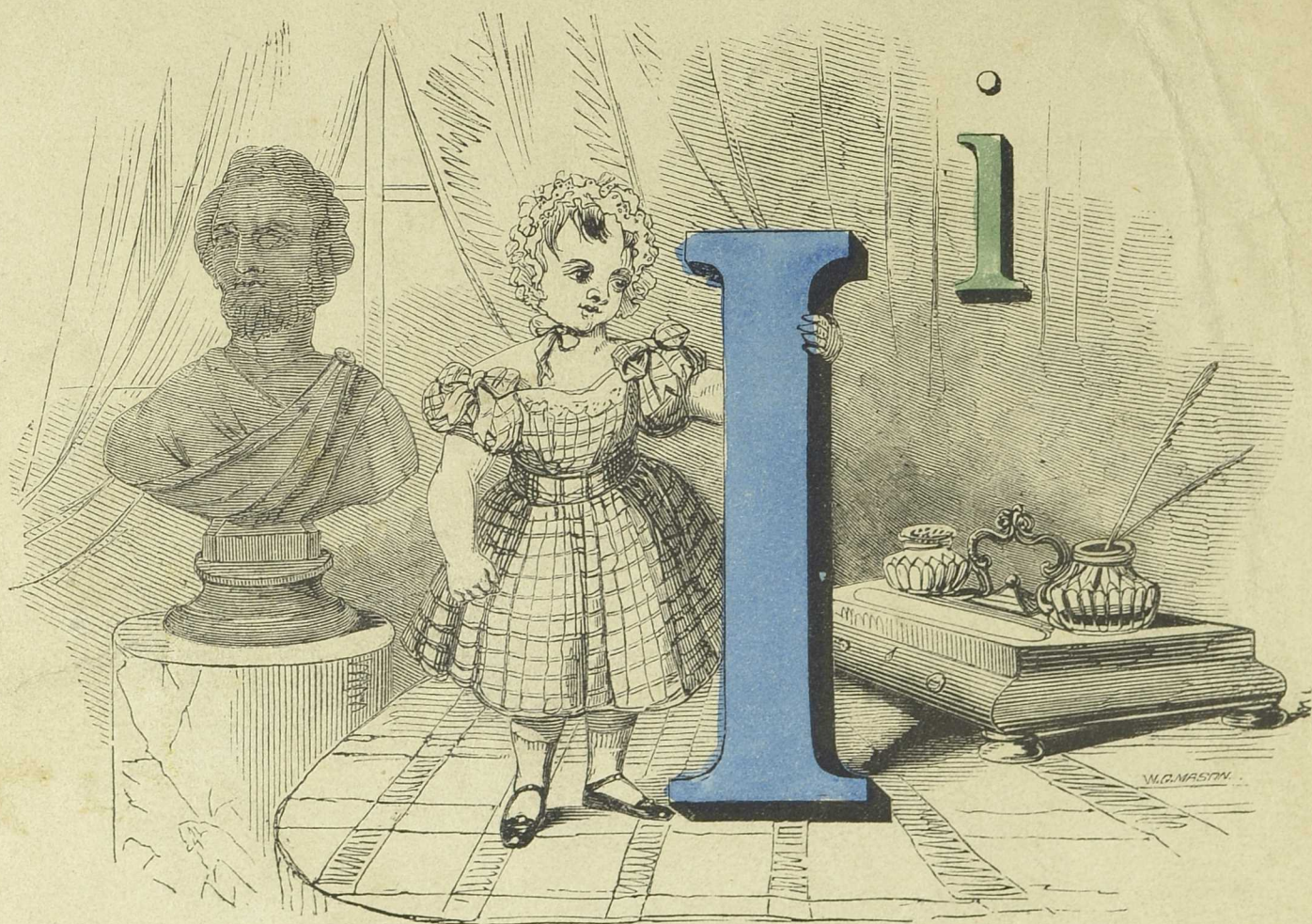
F begins Fox, and we

paces are swift.



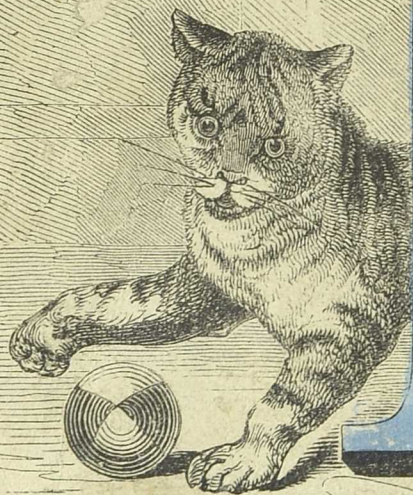
I is an Infant, and dressed

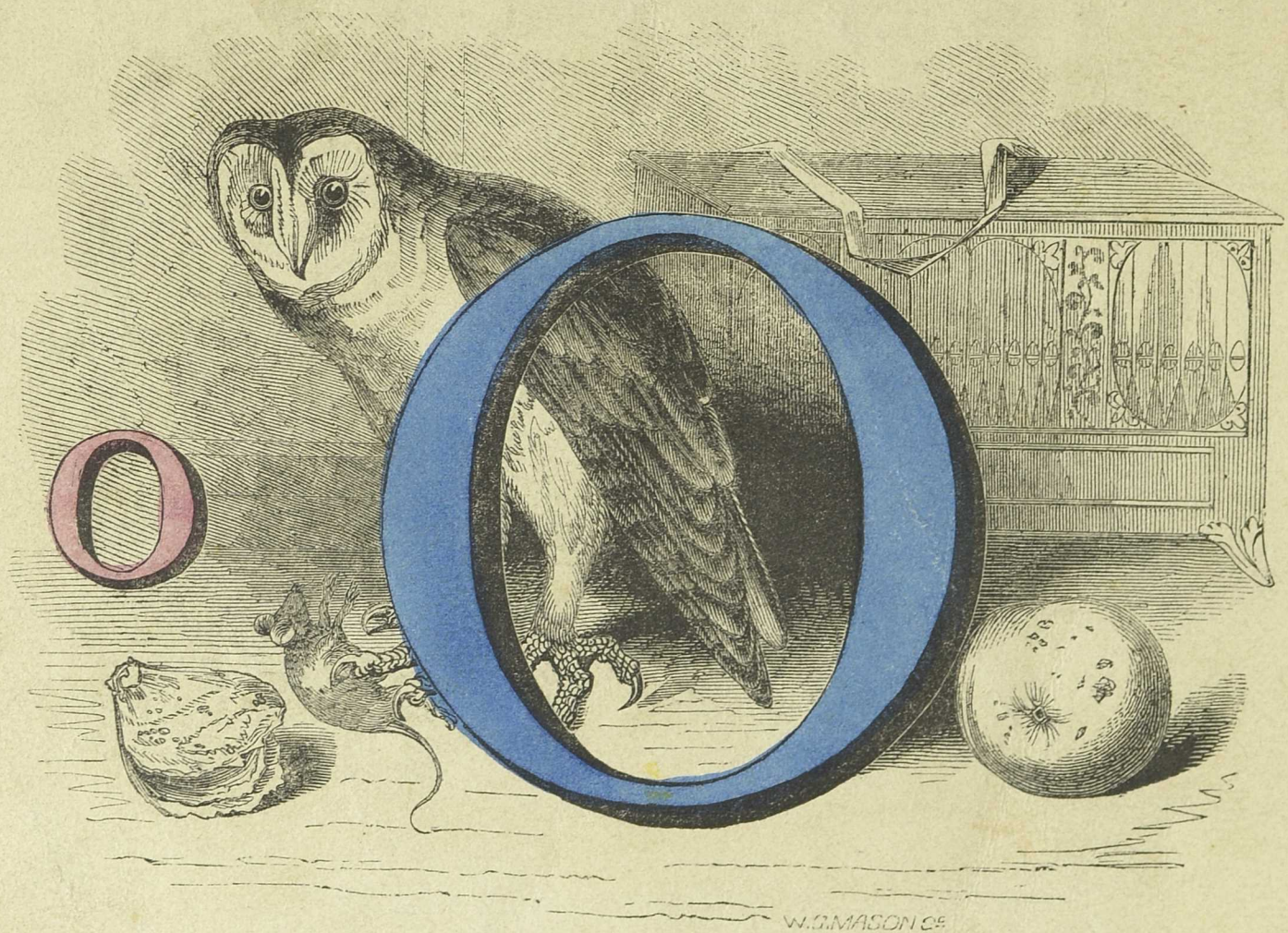
L is a Ladder, for climb-

grow on the trees.



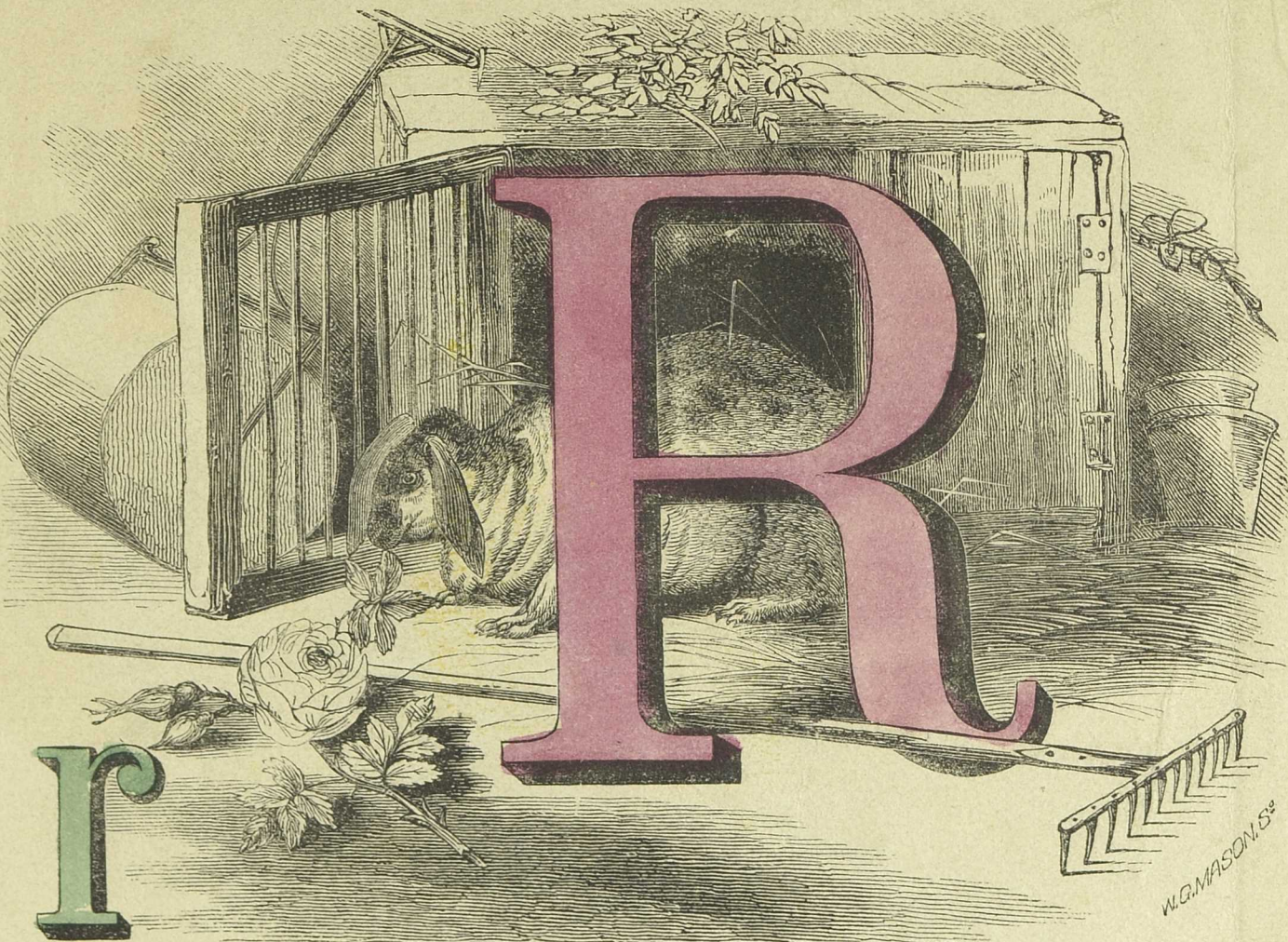
O stands for Owl, that
eats mice for its prey.



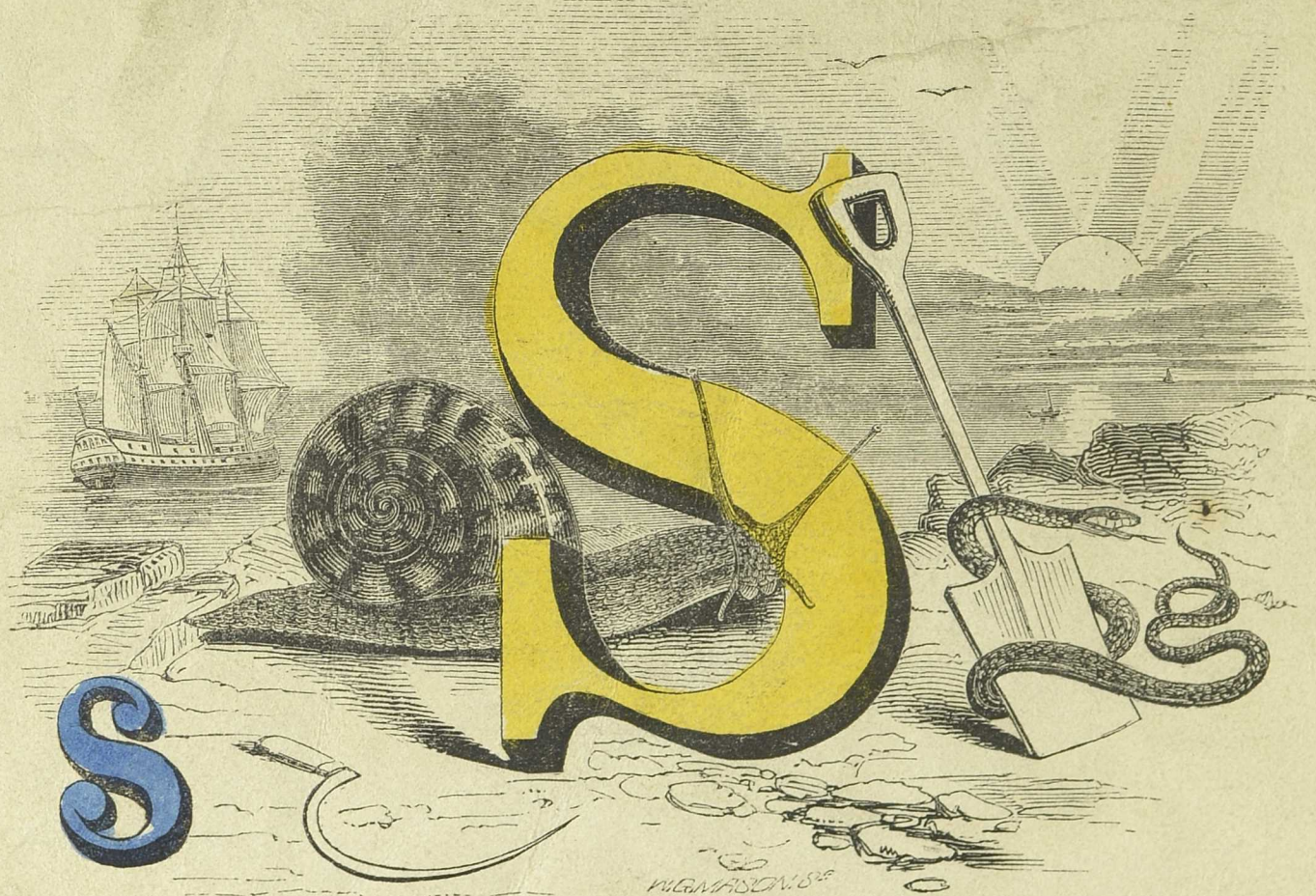
P stands for Parrots, some green and some grey.



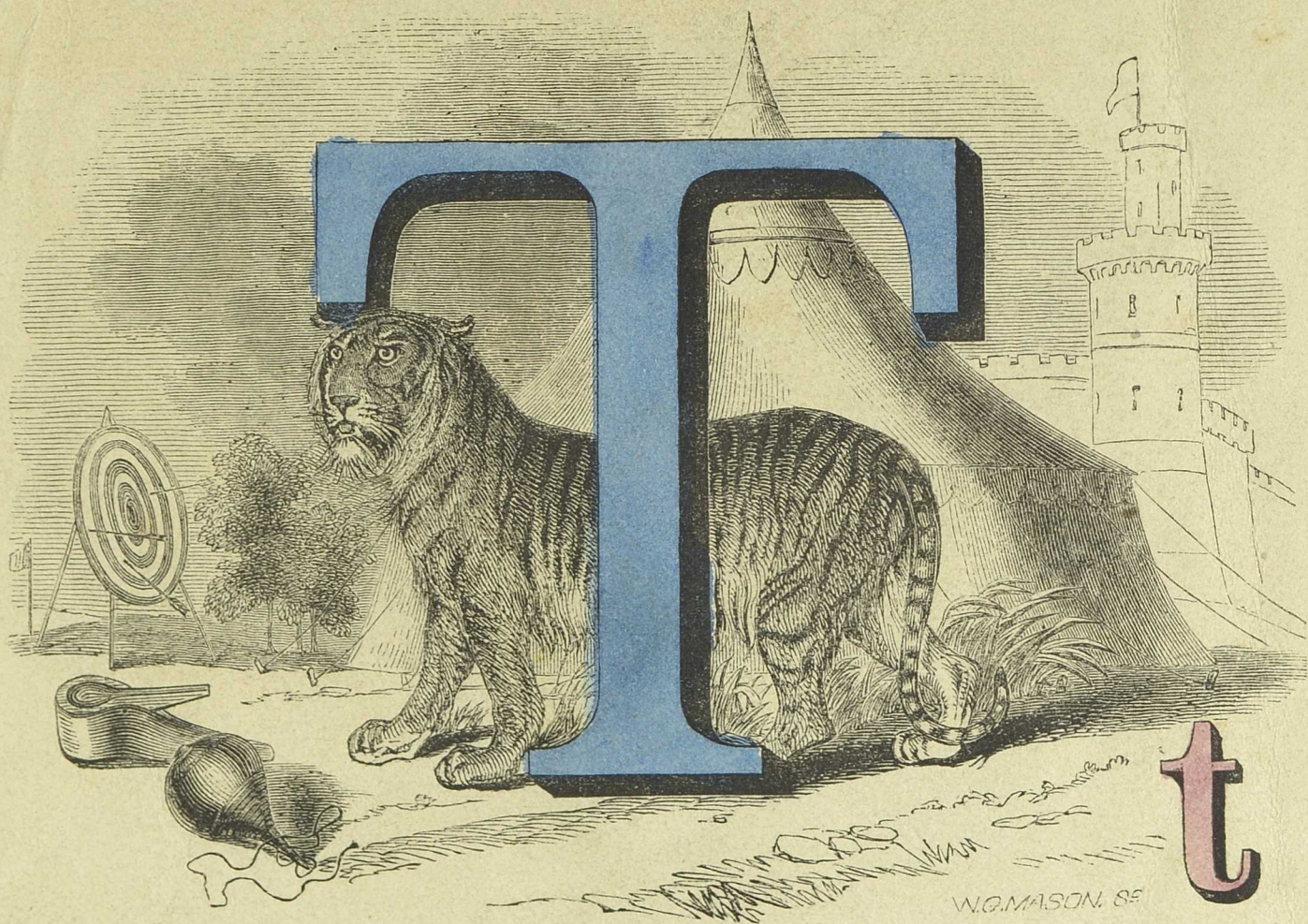
Q stands for Quills, from
the goose or the swan.



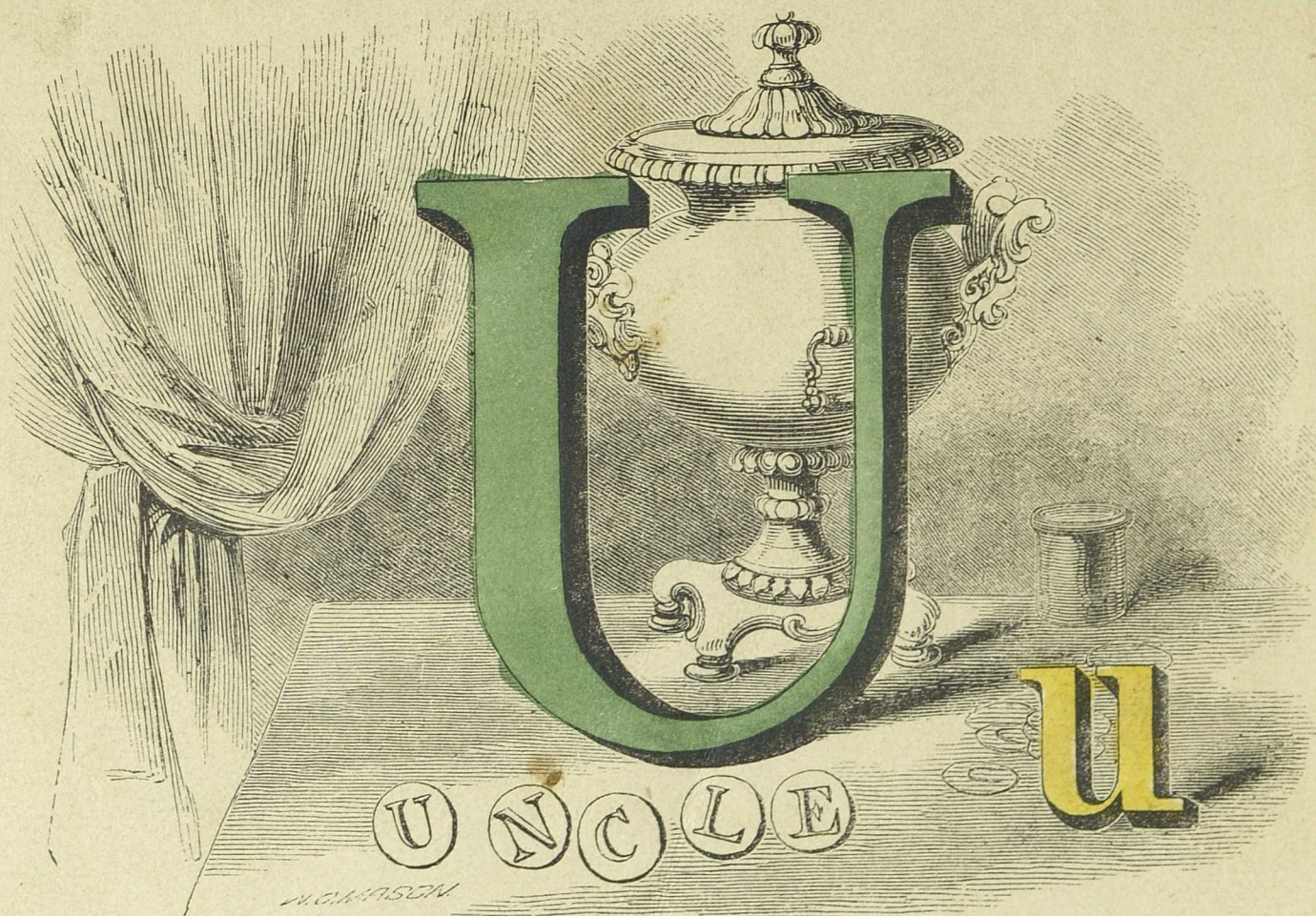
R stands for Rabbits, for

its house on its back.



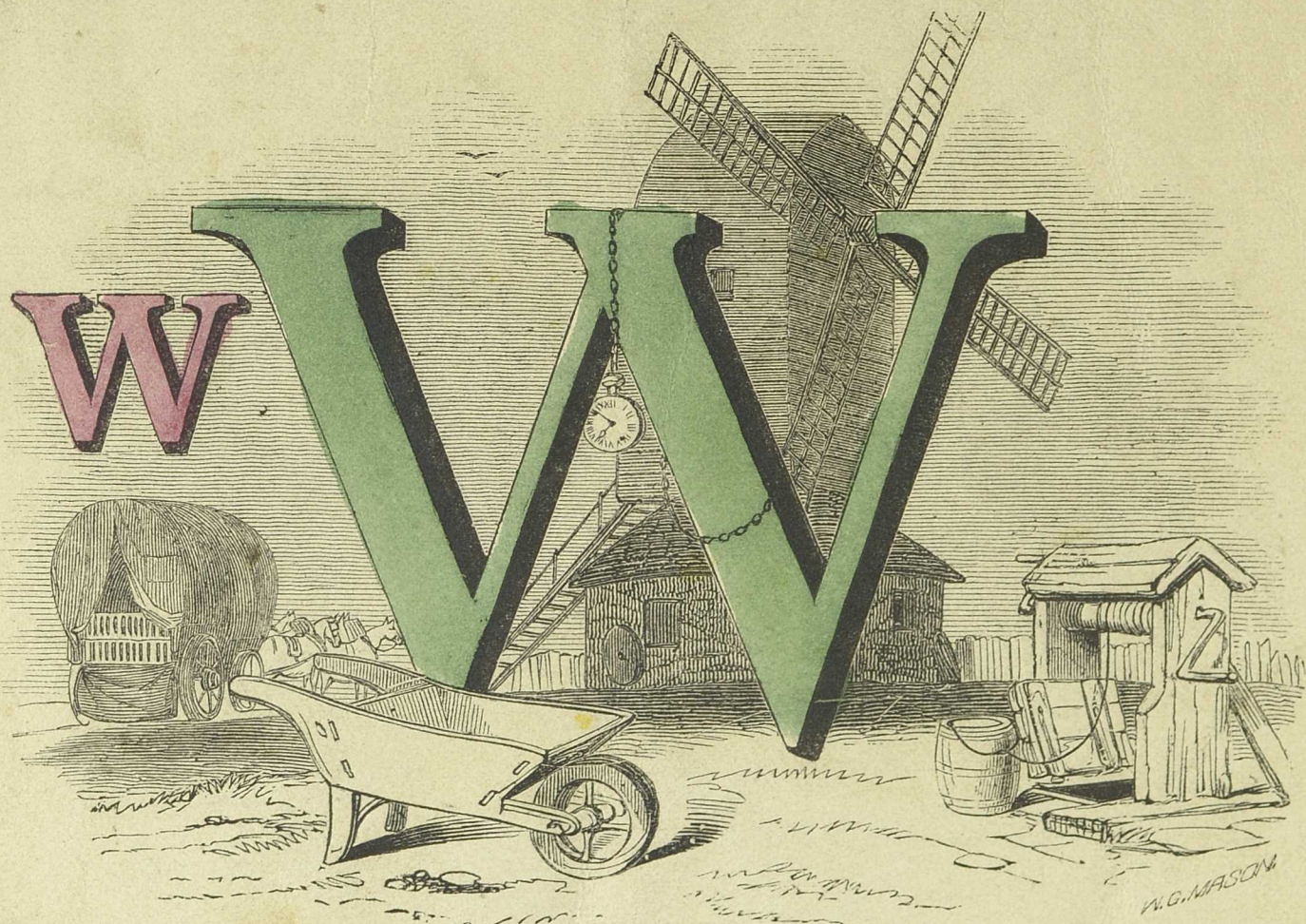
T stands for Tiger, striped
yellow and black.



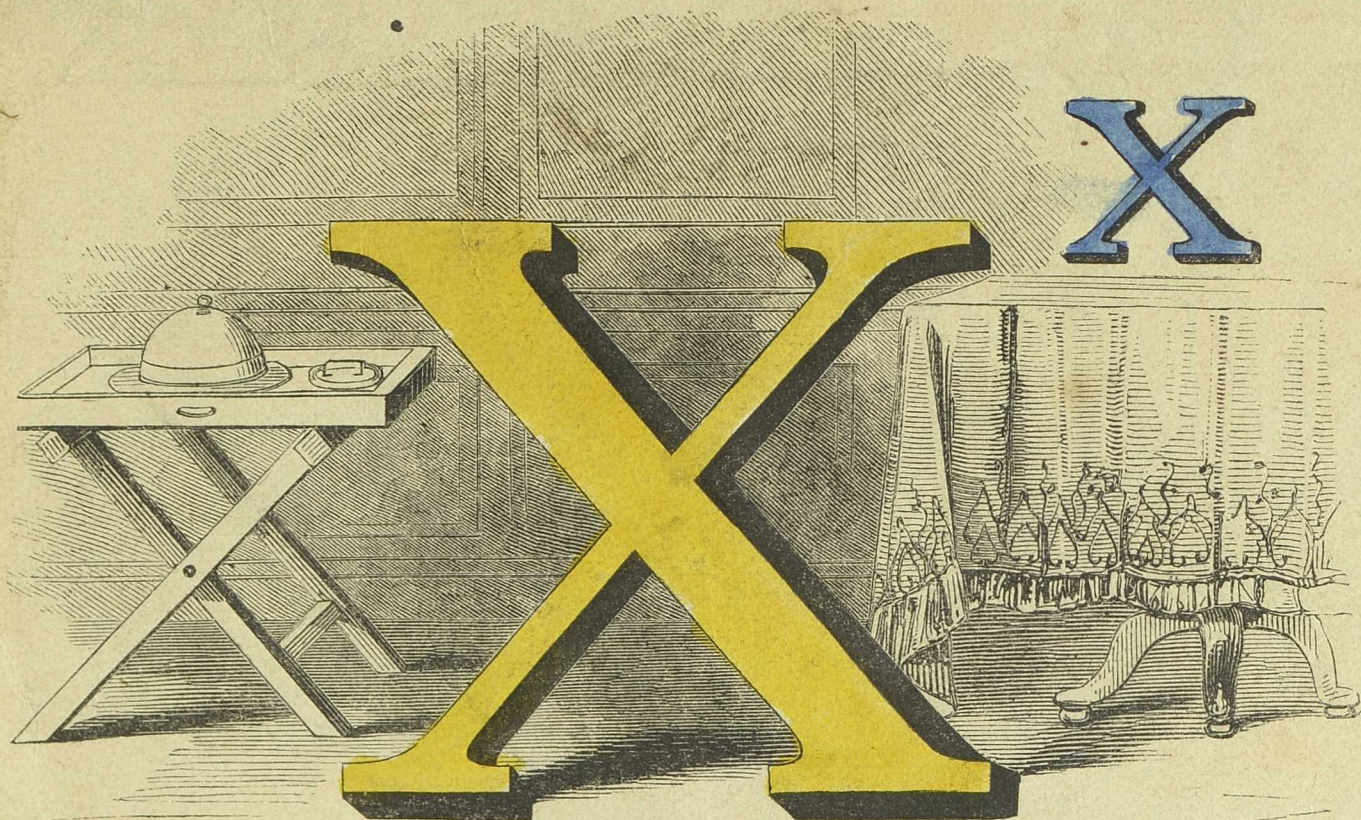
U stands for Urn, to hold

you may see.

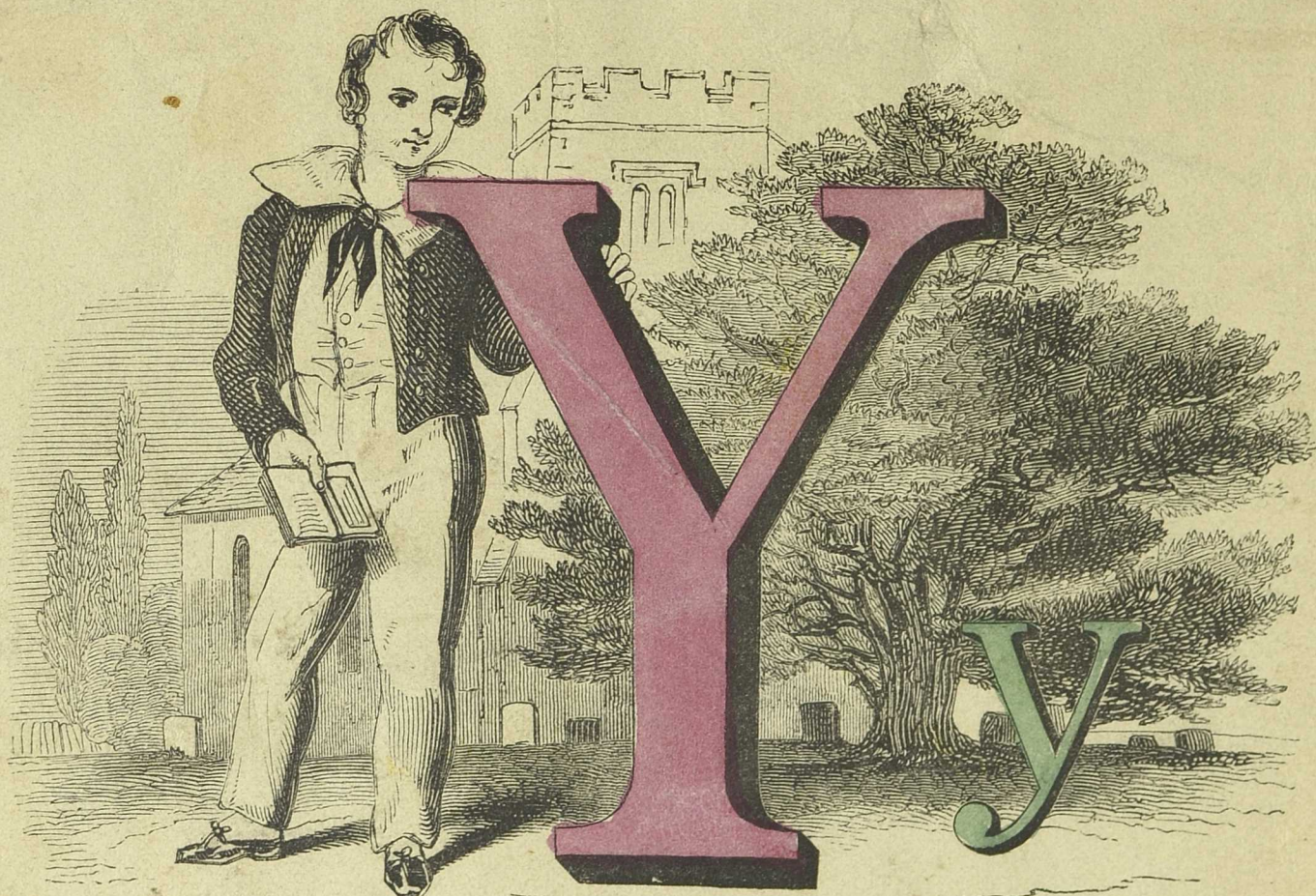


W is a Windmill, that
turns with the wind.

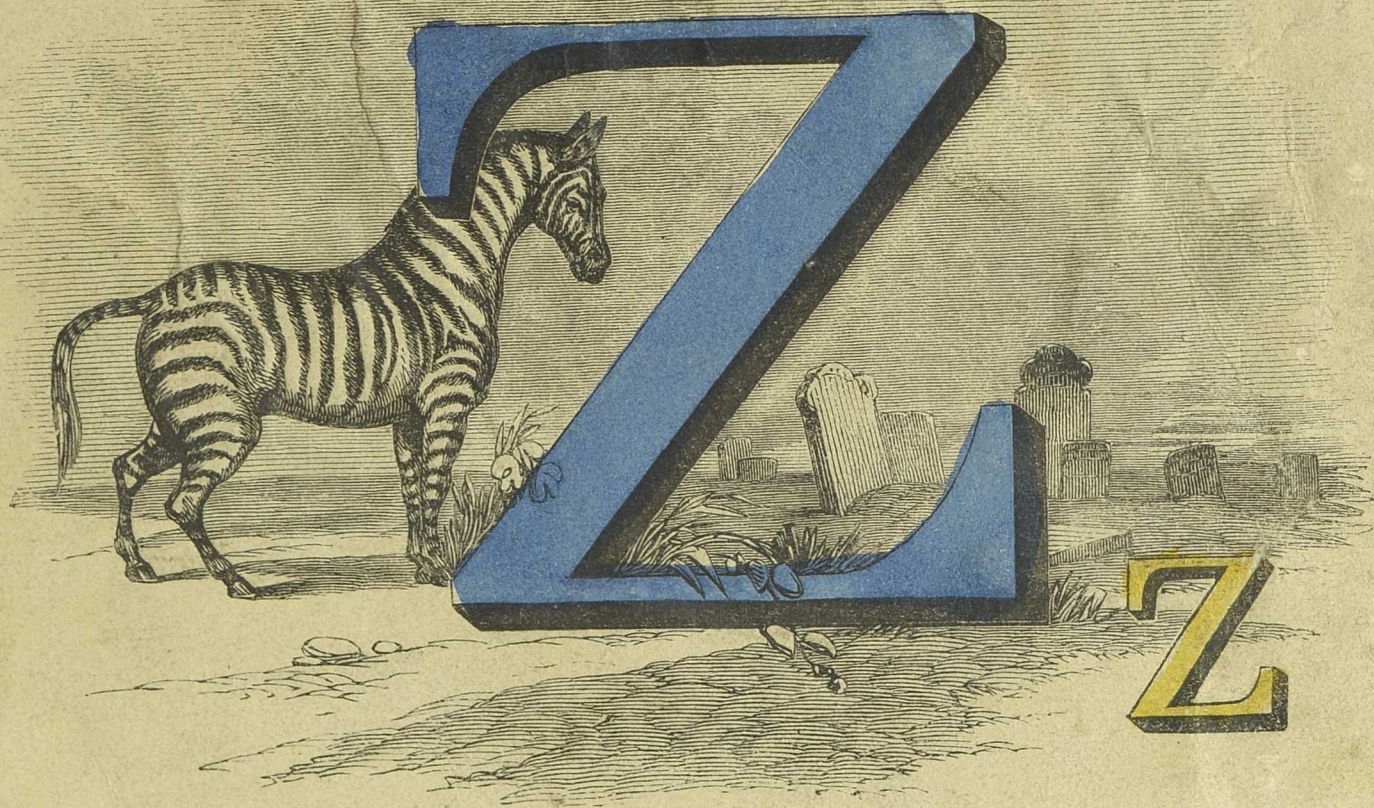
