

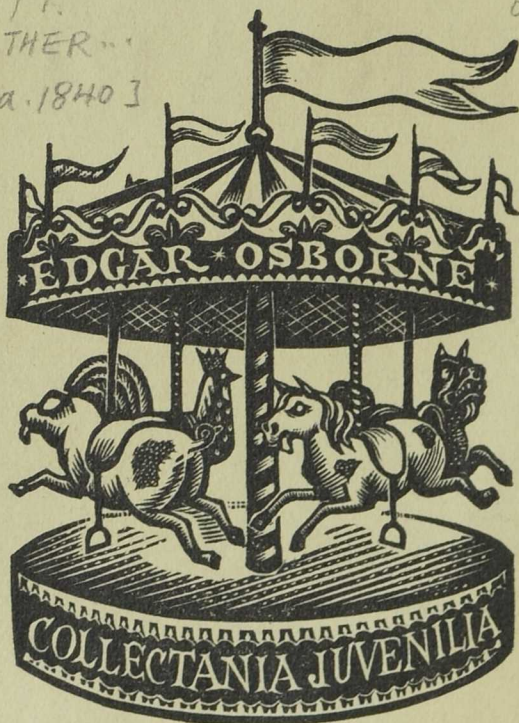

He was smoking his Pipe.

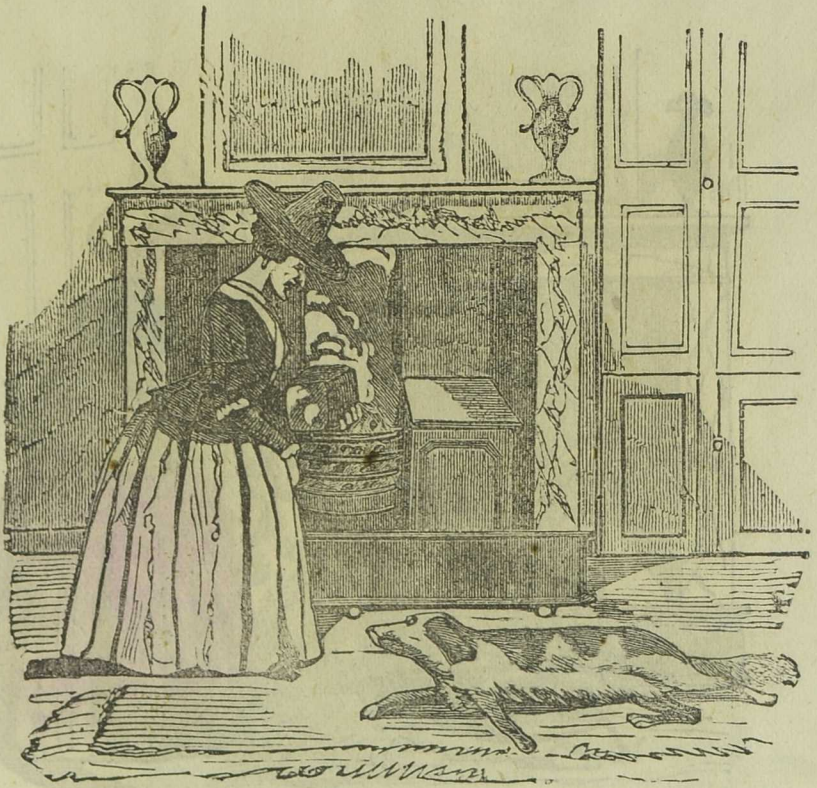


She went to the Market
