Kawartha Lakes District

The chain of lakes which comprises the Kawartha Lakes District lies north of Peterborough and Lindsay, and is composed of Lakes Katchewanooka, Clear, Stony, Buckhorn, Chemong, Pigeon, Bald, Sturgeon-Cameron, and Balsam, with a magnificent steamer route of seventy miles from Lakefield to Coboconk. Many of the lakes are dotted with islands, on which pretty and comfortable homes have been erected for summer tenants, and throughout the chain the tourist is nowhere far remote from busy town or village, or humble cottage home, yet is in comparative seclusion.

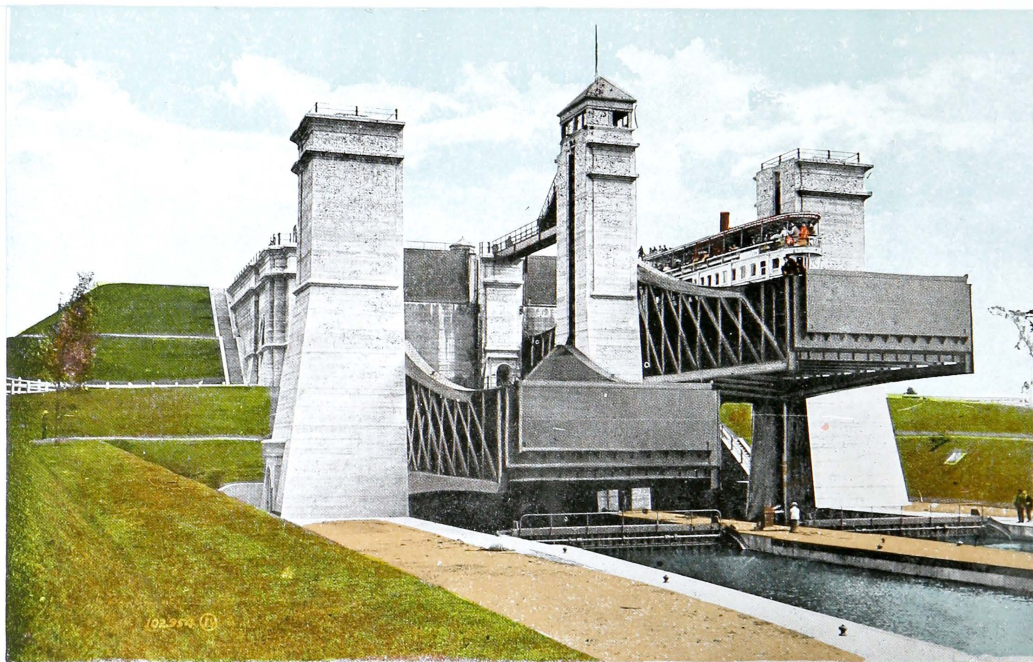

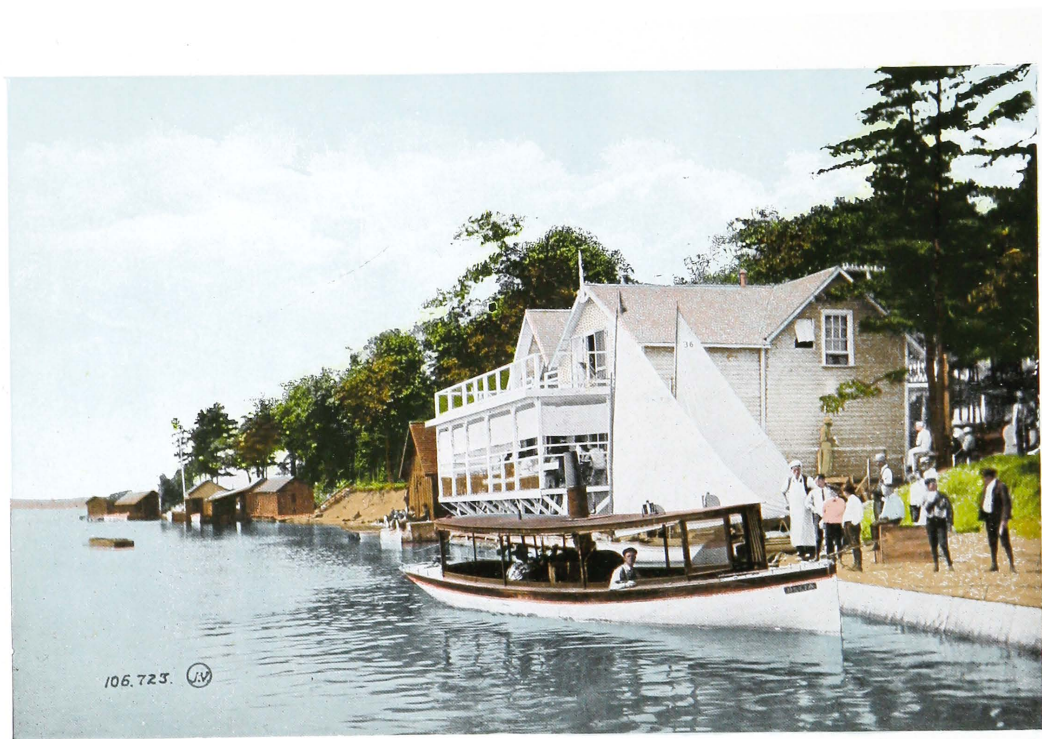

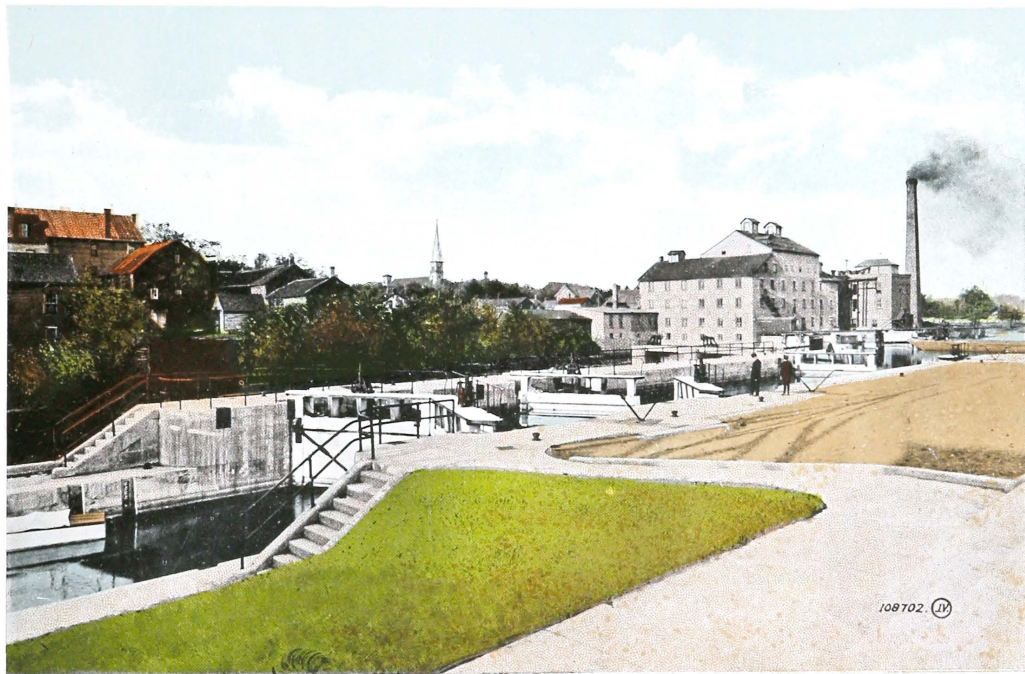

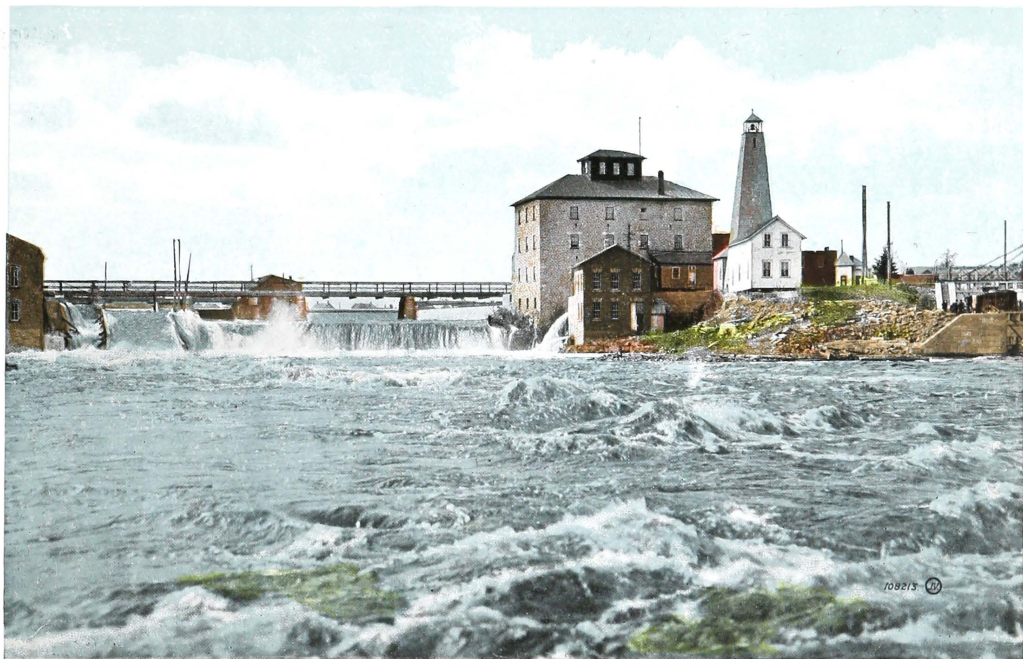

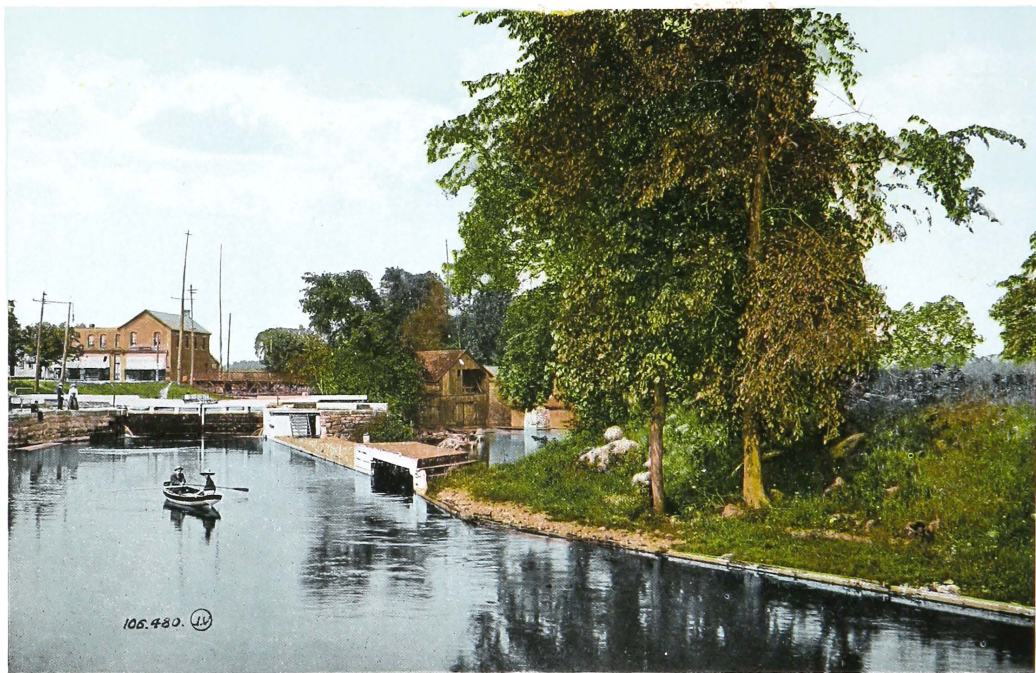

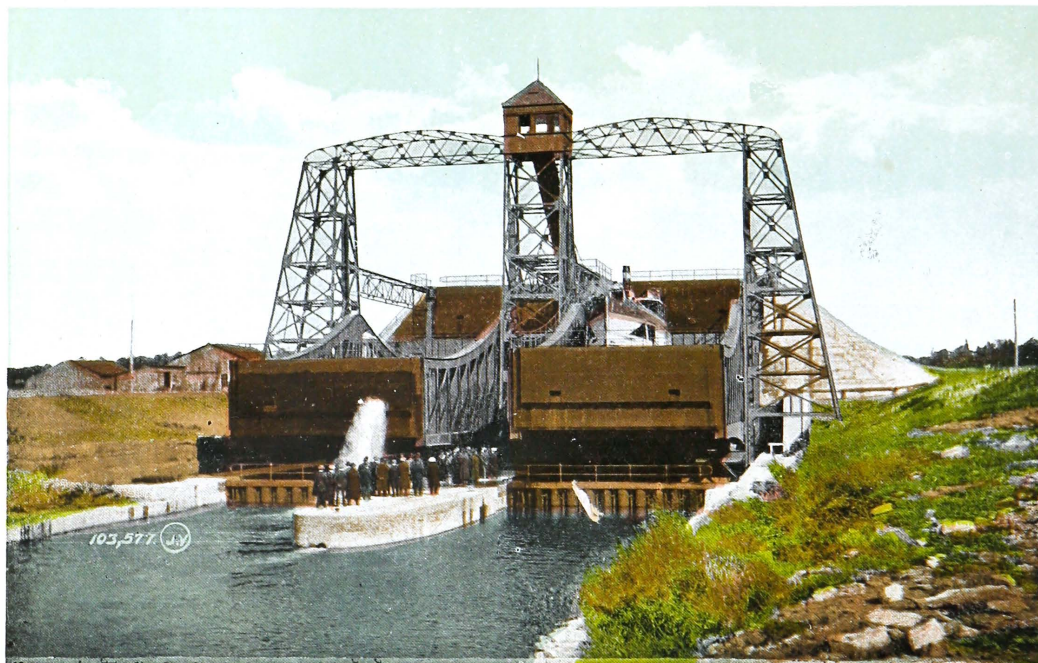
