## CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

1978 and 1979 have been years of continuing growth in the North York Public Library. One new branch was opened during this period. a storefront community branch in the Flemingdon Park Shopping Centre, Opened in April, 1978, and enthusiastically received by area residents, this branch will be replaced upon completion of the multimillion dollar Flemingdon Resource Centre, Sod-turning for this facility took place in the Fall of 1979, and library staff have been heavily involved in on-going planning activities.

Another Community Centre which will include a small branch library is in the planning stages for Avenue Road and Wilson Avenue. with construction anticipated for 1981. This should alleviate service needs of long-standing concern to both the library board and area residents

The future of the Central Branch in Willowdale continues to be a focus of planning both in terms of rehabilitating or replacing the existing building, and of restructuring the materials collection and services. North York Board of Control and Council have continued their practice of active library support by incorporating the recognized Central Branch needs into city development plans for the City Centre area.

Planning for automation of circulation control began early in 1978 in cooperation with the other public libraries in Metropolitan Toronto This should result in the coordinated implementation of compatible automated systems in the various libraries, thereby providing enhanced Metro-wide user services

A major reorganization of senior library staff was effected in 1978 with the abolishing of divisions and the regrouping of area and associated community branches. This has resulted in cost economies, increased organizational effectiveness, and more active participation in planning and management by operational staff.

Two members of our library board and senior administration were elected in 1979 to executive positions in the Ontario Library Association, Jean Orpwood, Deputy Chief Librarian will serve as Vice-President/President-elect, and I will have the pleasure of serving as President.

My continuing thanks go to staff at all levels whose skill, diligence and dedication contribute so indispensably to the excellence of our library system.
