I do by these Presents, by and with the advice of Her Majesty's Council, publish and proclaim, that I have seen fit to order that the Regulations and Directions contained in my Proclamations, in relation to Quarantine, bearing date the Thirtieth day of May and the Eighth day of August last, be and the same are hereby declared to be revoked.
