



CORD AND PULLEY OR PULL UP AWNINGS.

The principle point in a good awning is the fit, this will ensure its life. If not properly cut and put up, the canvas covering of the awning, no matter how heavy, will become a total wreck inside of one season. To avoid this state of things and a lot of further troubles, let us show you what we can do. We fully guarantee our work, and by looking at most of the leading stores and residences in Montreal, you will judge by yourself what our awning experts can do.

We keep the largest stock of awning stripes for you to select from and all enquiries are cheerfully and promptly answered to and estimates given by our agents the same day the calls are received.

In case you must take the measurements yourself, please read over carefully the following instructions.

 1° Give us the distance between the figures 1 to 2 (or height) 2 to 3 (or extension) 3 to 4 (or front) on the following diagram :




 2° Make sure that the place where the awning is to be fastened is straight and level, otherwise mention what is in the way.

3° Say if it is to be fastened to brick, wood, stone or iron.

 4° In case the awning should exceed 12 feet Front, the frame will need to be supported by additional extension arms. Determine which is the best place for so doing, a column or any solid part of the building will suit the purpose.


5° What color do you prefer? white natural duck or fancy stripes. The best colors are Tan, Green or Red, but the best duck to stand the weather is white. For colored illustrations of Stripes see page 18



AWNING FRAMES.

One piece of solid iron 5% inch. diameter, with galvanized tips and slide rods. No bolt to pierce the cloth, and so strong that they will never sway sideways.


ROLLER AWNINGS.

A 60 foot Roller lowered.

Roller awnings are rapidly taking the place of cord and pulley awnings for stores. The reasons for this are numerous. First of all, with a long pull-up awning, two persons at least are needed to lift it, and yet with considerable annoyance, while a child will operate with ease a 20 foot roller.

The appearance is also greatly improved, a glance at the accompanying photographs of two of Montreal's leading stores, fitted with our roller awnings, and shown here after one year's service will convince you more than any argument. And what about the lasting qualities ? they are simply doubled, as with the new system, we do away with all the cords passing through rings (as in the old style) and tearing the piece away from the awning.


The Rollers themselves, are made of solid steel tubing, (not iron). Every fitting is galvanized and rust proof. The box operating it is of a new design, very simple in its working and tested to support 1700 pounds.




DIRECTIONS FOR MEASURING.

In taking measurements for window or door awnings, measure from 1 to 2, 2 to 3, 3 to 4, 4 to 5, as shown in cut. NOTE.—The distance from 3 to 4, which is the width of the awnings, should be taken from center of casing on one side to the center of casing on the other side.

PORCH AWNINGS AND DROP CURTAINS


(For Balconies, Verandahs, Etc.)

Nothing adds more to the beauty and comfort of a residence than neat and elegant awnings.

There are cases where drop curtains are preferred to awnings for galleries: We have a very neat system for adjusting this kind of work. They are made with eyelets along the top to attach with screw eyes and pole in hem at bottom. Cords are attached at top at a suitable distance from the ends, and pass down in front of curtains underneath the pole, then up the inside of the curtain to and through pulleys, then both cords leads to one end. By pulling on the two cords, the curtain will roll snugly to the top.


Comfortable Compartment Family Tent.

This tent was fitted with sectionnal wood flooring and canvas partitions same height as the walls of the tent, dividing it in two bedrooms and large dining room. When wanted, a part of the walls may be lifted up and rest on extra poles so as to make a perfect awning, giving free circulation of air throughout the tent, besides affording a beautiful shade.





The art of sailmaking is one of the most ancient as well as the most honored of professions, and dealing as it does with a variety of shapes and textures of cloth, its proper practice entails the possession of a large amount of skill and experience. This is more so to-day than formerly, as the modern sailmaker has not only to make heavy canvases for ships of burden, but his skill is called upon to produce light-weight sails for racing pleasure vessels.

In all our sails from the lightest to the heaviest we use the best of materials, and we give to every detail of the work our closest attention. To yacht sails especially we give our best experience, taking the greatest care in cutting and roping them so as to get a perfect draft, and to prevent them working and bagging out of proper shape It must be remembered that more bad sails are made by the user than are made by the sailmaker, and we cannot sufficiently impress upon our customers the necessity of taking great care in taking the measurements they send us. When measuring for a sail, be sure and leave plenty of room on the spar for the stretch, as short spars are the cause of making more bad sails than anything else; we have all weights of canvas and will be pleased to furnish samples on request.

When ordering sails, give full particulars as to number and depth of reefs, mast hoops, lacing, etc.

Another class of work for which our special machines are perfectly adapted is that of making awnings for yachts, we carry an extended line of these goods, and can guarantee the quality and price as well as the artistic finish to be unequalled.


Directions for Bending Sails.

In bending a new suit of sails to your spars, DO NOT, under any circumstances, use a tackle or purchase to haul out the mainsail along the gaff and boom. If you do this, you will ruin the set of the sail, irrevocably.

Lace the head and foot of the sail on, without stretching, and it will take care of itself. After the sail has been used a short time, it will become slack at the head and foot ; then haulit out gently, as before. Do not condemn a sail because it is not "flat as a board," the moment it is first hoisted. Use it for a time as above directed, and you will have no trouble A new sail—like a new pair of shoes—must be broken in before it will be thoroughly satisfactory.


In our small yacht suits we place a draw string in the leach of our mainsails, which device has been found most useful in doing away with a flapping leach. In the larger sails we use battens.

Cover your sails at night with sail-covers, to protect them from rain and dew. When they are damp, never allow them to remain furled a moment longer than it necessary. A few hours of sunshine on a damp sail, when furled, will cause it to sweat, and mildew to set in.







MEASURING FOR SAILS.

Exercise the greatest care in taking measurements. If your boat or yacht is already sparred send us the exact length of her masts, booms and gaffs, together with the following measurements : The distance from bowsprit end to mast The distance from stem to mast.

The distance from goose neck or saddle to throat Halliard block.


The distance from soddle or goose neck to deck. The distance from throat to clew, called the "diagonal."

The length of each jib stay.

SAIL COVERS.

For Jibs—State length of sail when furled and the girth at three or four points.

A BRIEF DESCRIPTION

O^{UR} motors are all of the four cycle type. In designing the Buffalo, simplicity and easy access to every part was the object in view, and we have a motor that is easy to operate and every part can be easily removed without disturbing any other. The crank shafts are steel forgings on which are adjusted ring oilers by means of which the oil is thrown into the bearings, thus making lubrication positive and doing away with the splash system which is neither desirable nor reliable. The ring oilers, main base bearings and cylinders are lubricated by means of a neat multiple feed oiler which is put on the motor in such a way that it can be adjusted and kept horizontal even if the motor is set at an angle in the boat. The connecting rods are also steel forgings having an adjustment at the top for the crosshead. The uprights, cams, valves and lifters are also made of the best steel ; the valve lifters are made of square stock and work in bronze casings which are put into the crank chamber, thus preventing them from rusting or sticking. The cylinders and pistons are ground.

Both inlet and exhaust values are mechanically operated, and the value cams instead of being simply pinned on the cam shaft are held in place by means of Woodruff keys, making it possible to remove them and to also get them back in exactly the right position.

Our motors are equipped with the jump spark or the make and break system of ignition. Our make and break plugs are perfection, and can be easily removed from the motor. The sparker cams are carried on a square cam shaft which renders it impossible for the cam to slip and get out of time.
