The story of the Little Tycoon is told without unnecessary waste of words. In the first act a company of touring collegians is shown on the deck of an ocean greyhound steamer "White Star." Gen. Knickerbocker's daughter, Violet, is in love with Alvin Barry, an energetic young American, but her father wants her to marry an English nobleman, one Lord Dolphin. Violet's bosom friend, Dolly Dimple, and Alvin's college chum, Rufus Ready, determine to aid the young couple in their love affairs, and the college boys and girls, who are represented by members of the chorus, also lend their assistance. Knickerbocker is about to give his daughter to the fraudulent Dolphin when the real Dolphin and his valet come on the scene and the audience sees four deities. Alvin is ordered out of the house, but, not dismayed by defeat, he disguises himself as the Great Tycoon of Japan, and is received at a lawn party by Knickerbocker, who, not perceiving his repeated deception, gives him Violet in marriage. Thus the disguise is discarded, Alvin takes Violet, old Knickerbocker proposes to Miss Harkissine. Curtain.
