From the above interview the marriage took place the coming week.

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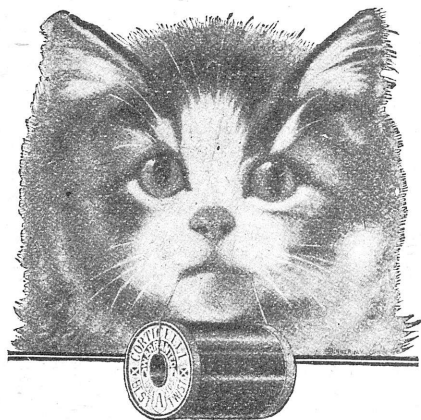
