A prominent firm in Western Ontario who employ an Advertising Agency to do their ad. writing is advertising goods for summer wear in October and if results are bad they will blame the Newspapers.

All last winter a well-known stove manufacturer was advertising to have a "cool kitchen" you should get a——Fine Range and he wondered why they did not sell.

To get results from advertising your ads must be seasonable as well as beautiful.

Never try to reach the consumer through the trade reach the trade through the consumer.

A daily publication is better than a weekly and a weekly is better than a monthly in those days of rush people soon forget.

A good pulling ad. should never be changed.

Never try to educate the public, try to sell them what you have to sell.

Use common words and plain language in all advertising, remember you are talking to the public not college professors.
