

General Information

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Entries close on August 11th.
- 2. The show will be open from 9 a.m. to 10.00 p.m. daily. Daylight Saving time. (The duration of Show shall be from 9 a.m., Monday to Thursday, 6 p.m.).
- 3. No dog will be received before noon on Saturday, Sept. 3rd, or after noon on Monday, September 5th.
- 4. Judging will commence promptly on Monday afternoon, September 5th, at 2.00 o'clock.
- 5. Only the prize cards or ribbons of the Canadian National Exhibition of 1927 will be permitted on the kennels, but exhibitors can place a list of winnings if they wish.
- 6. Entries must be made on blanks furnished by the Canadian National Exhibition Association.
- 7. ENTRANCE FEE to all classes, except Variety Classes, \$3.00 for each first entry, and \$1.00 for each subsequent entry of same dog. The Entrance Fee must, in all cases, accompany the entry, and includes care and feed of dogs during the show. Entrance fee to Variety Classes, \$4.00 each entry. Entrance fee to Brace and Team Classes, \$1.00, but all dogs must be entered in one of the classes provided for in their breed.
- 8. The Bench Show Committee will use diligence for the care and safety of all dogs exhibited. Watchmen will be kept on duty day and night, but it must be distinctly understood by all exhibitors that the management will not be responsible for loss or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other cause.
- 9. No dog will be received unless supplied with a suitable collar and chain. Bench Show chains are the safest.
 - 10. Exhibitors must abide by any errors made in entering their dogs.
 - 11. The Superintendent will have entire charge and control of the show.
- 12. As soon as possible after August 11th, each exhibitor will receive a ticket of identification and a numbered tag corresponding with the stall number of his dog, which must be attached to the collar when the dog is brought to the exhibition hall, and the person accompanying the dog must show his ticket of identification before the animal will be received. In case of dogs coming by express, tags with corresponding number must be made out and attached to the crate. Exhibitors are requested to have their name and address on all crates.
- 13. No dog will be permitted to pass out of the building at night until its owner shall deposit \$5.00 with the Superintendent, which will be returned on the return of the dog next morning before 10.00 o'clock. If prize-winners are taken out and not returned before 10.00 a.m., the prizes awarded them will be forfeited. A season ticket for entry into the Bench Show will be issued to every exhibitor free, and will be for his or her use only. The ticket will be forfeited if transferred.

14. The Committee reserve the right to themselves to refuse any entry that

they may think fit to exclude.

15. Exhibitors will be allowed to exercise their dogs between the hours 7.00 to 10.00 a.m., 1.00 to 2.00 p.m., and from 6.00 p.m. to 7.00 p.m.

16. During the hours of judging no dog shall be taken from its stall, not even by its owner, and if any dog is not found in its stall when called for by the judge, the judging will proceed without it. This rule will be rigidly enforced, that the judging may not be retarded. Owners are requested to be near their dogs, and when the class is called to bring them into the judging ring.

- 17. Dogs sent by express must be addressed in the name of exhibitor, care of the Superintendent, Dog Show, Canadian National Exhibition, Toronto, Ont., charges prepaid. Attach to the box a label with the name and address of the exhibitor; also name of the express company by which the box should be returned.
- 18. Exhibitors winning prize money are requested to file a statement of their winnings with the Superintendent. Forms may be had at the Superintendent's office. Prize money will be mailed immediately after the close of the show.
- 19. No dog not duly entered at the show will be allowed within the precincts of the show. The penalty for infraction of this rule will be expulsion from the show and forfeiture of any prizes that may have been won.
- 20. No numbers shall, under any circumstances, be changed from one bench to another, and no dog shall be benched on any bench but its own.
- Any person found making any change from one location to another shall be liable to forfeit their entrance fees, and their dogs may be ordered from the show building.
- 21. Exhibitors desiring to sell their dogs must state price in entry blank. The price will be printed in catalogue and any person shall have the right to purchase from the Superintendent at price stated. Should there be two or more claims for any one dog so entered, the dog will be put to auction, (at the close of the show), and half of the surplus over and above entered selling price to go to the funds of the Canadian National Exhibition.

IMPORTANT—READ CAREFULLY

Definition of Classes

The Puppy Class shall be for dogs six months of age and under twelve months of age on the first day of the show, and no entry can be made of one whose date of birth, breeder, sire and dam is unknown.

The Novice Class shall be for Canadian or American-bred dogs, never having won a first prize at any show recognized by the Canadian Kennel Club or the American Kennel Club, wins in the Puppy Class excepted. No entry for Novice Class can be made that does not give the name and address of the breeder and place of birth of the dog.

An American-bred dog is one bred in the United States of America. Dogs bred and whelped in the United States, and dogs whelped in the United States by a bitch purchased by a citizen of the United States in any foreign country and subsequently bred by him to a foreign dog, shall be considered American-bred, providing proof of such breeding is furnished to the club.

The Canadian-Bred Class shall be for all dogs bred in the Dominion of Canada. No Champions shall be eligible.

Dogs bred and whelped in Canada, and dogs whelped in Canada by a bitch purchased by a citizen of Canada in any foreign country, and subsequently bred by him to a foreign dog, shall be considered Canadian-bred.

The Limit Class shall be for all dogs never having won four first prizes in the Limit Class at any shows recognized by the Canadian Kennel Club or the American Kennel Club, but no dog having obtained a title of Champion anywhere shall be eligible for this class.

The Open Class shall be for all dogs over six months of age the first day of the show. No dogs not entered in any of the classes will be allowed within the precincts of the Show. This rule will be rigidly enforced.

The Winners' Class, for which there shall be no entry fee, shall be open only to winners of first prizes in the Puppy, Novice, Canadian-bred, Limit or Open Classes.

The Breeders' Class shall be for dogs and bitches bred by the exhibitor and must have been owned by exhibitor for at least three months prior to closing of entry.

The Variety Classes shall be for all dogs except Champions.

Brace Class shall be for two of one breed, irrespective of sex, belonging to the same owner, and entered in their respective classes. The dogs comprising the brace need not be named at the time of entry, but simply entered as Mr. ——'s brace. (Entry Fee, \$1.00.)

Team Class shall be for four of one breed, irrespective of sex, belonging to the same owner, and entered in their respective classes. The dogs comprising the team need not be named at the time of entry, but simply entered as Mr. ——'s team. (Entry Fee, \$1.00.)


