Crocodiles are found in S America.

Gargoyles or heronries, with every kind of heron, stork, crane and ibis, some snow white, delicate blue or brilliant scarlet.

In water are the sting ray with a horrible poisoned spine, the payara with snake fangs, the electric eel, above all the Caribe, like a stout gold fish with bulldog head & underhanging jaw.

Black ayanti - kind of pig.

Curassowa birds - up lofty trees.

Pirarucu - edible fish, large.

Sandpipers, teal, brown ibis.

Black Ternans.

White bell bird, size of a pygmy.

Female Jaguar has longer shriller cry than male.

Iles Tigrina, wild cat.

Murky flesh of Cayman.

Macaco - monkey.

Phyllostoma hastatum - Vampire bat.

Dolphin - manatee.

Ferocious anti. ticks, Jiggers, leeches, mosquitos.

Peccary. gland on back to be excised.

Lobo.

The flesh of the running bird is every where.

Rattle snake on open Campos.

Iaracaca - Snake that attacks man.

Plants

Tarina - preparation of flower.

Mandioc, Plantains.

Second growth woods worse than Virgin Forest.

Purple berries of Melastoma

Huge cedars, great silk cotton trees.

Graceful Assai Palms 100 feet high.

Majestic ~~Guamia~~ Muruti Palms.

Everything covered with Convolvulus, passion flowers & Bryonias.

Gigantic trees draped in golden Allamandas. Scarlet stars of Tacsonia. Rich blue of Ipomoea. Undergrowth of Phoenix & Coco palms. Deep crimson creeping flowers of Cyrtodiria on banks of streams.

Miltonia Vexillaria with Oncidium Carthaginense. Orchids here also the magnificent pink and scarlet of Cattleya Triana and Odontoglossum.

As you ascend a mountain you come from the thick growth of the vegetable ivory palm to the bamboo, and then to the region of tree ferns. Manicaria Palms only grow in damp places.

Cow tree - palo de vaca.

Up the hills you get calcedarias, Verbenas &
Heliotropes.

Root called Babasco, used for poisoning water &
to killing fish.

Europe has had more valuable economic
plants & fewer valuable animals from
South America than anywhere.

You may pass days & see no flowers

India rubber from sap of *Sophorica Elastica*.

Horse tail mosses from every bough.

Brazilian wax palm (*Copernicia*) the
most useful tree in the world 599.

Typical Geographical Points

The medanos or low sand dunes which alter their shape with the wind.

The Orinoco and the Amazon connect through the Rio Negro.

Pongo ... a gorge.
Cochas ... a lakes.

It is a granite continent hollowed out in great basins by water action & these basins filled with forests.

Indians

Zambo - half negro, half Indian.

Various half breeds are Chinos, Cascos, mestizos, Curibocos &c.

Goajiros are wild Indians of Colombia.

Drum language of the Iwarios tribes.

The high stepping walk of a marsh tribe.

Macus of Rio Negro are absolute savages. Many of the natives are below the stone age, absolutely unable to fashion anything. Chiquito tribes have no minerals, though the lowest Andeans & Papuans can get up to 2. The lowest tribes live near Lake Titicaca.

Indians are usually reserved & unpassive, a Mongolian trait - half Mongolian, half Caucasian. Polysynthetic speech different from any other in its essential construction. 100 separate languages with no relation to each other & nothing in common save Polyphetic character.

Mundurucu - on N Bank of Amazon.

Chunchos Indians, unconquered even by the Incas, inhabit the head of the Amazon.

Cusco, the old Inca Capital, was 280 miles from Pacific. Savagery beyond it.

Amaquacas - wild tribe of Peruvian Border.
They cry like bears in the woods to decoy hunters & eat them.

Indias mansos - tame.

" bravos - wild

Mopo Indians of Bolivia best boatmen.

Mirankas - Cannibals on Putumayo.

General Remarks about S America

The whole population of the Continent is less than that of the British Islands.

It is remarkable that the Portuguese have always conducted their political changes without bloodshed while the Spanish have always been the other way

After Brazil became Portuguese they sprang up a race half Indian half Portuguese named Paulistas who showed enormous energy & conquered Brazil for Portugal

The population of South America consists of whites, Indians, and negroes, but miscegenation is so great that it is rare in any settled district to find any pure family of either breed.

Brazil is so named from a red wood known by that name in Chaucer's time

There is a debatable region between Peru & Ecuador - also between Peru & Colombia.

East & South of Brazil mountains
West & North flat.

The atmosphere of the higher plains is
delightful after the gloom & damp of the
forests with their constant heavy odors of
decay. Birds, flowers & scents of savannah.

In the great forests both the animals & the
plants are climbers, all working up
toward the light. Jasmine, nettle &
lemon climb. Even a palm tree, the
Jacitara, climbs.

As the land ascends the trees are less lofty &
further apart. The long broad glossy leaves
& creepers are absent. Flowers are more
profuse - ferns - Brazilian Pine
(Araucaria) - the only cone-bearer.

Sertões - name for barren upland

Miscellaneous Points

There are barrows' graves or Huacas in Colombia
many of which contain much gold.

Soroche. Impetuous Mountain Malady.

Once the Indians poisoned the wells with
a kind of upas tree that they never recovered.

The Amazon.

The Amazon has a sluggish current with
numerable backwaters, side streams & lagoons,
flooded or dry in the various seasons.

The scene of the story would be between 0 & 10 N.L.
Long from 70 to 80 W. Ascending the Amazon they
would pass the town of Santarem - Rio Negro on N Bank
connecting with Orinoco. Paro Parro River on South.
Pass the Japura River. Then come to the stream with
the concealed mouth.

Amazon is pale yellow or olive in color. Some branches
black & some milky. You can tell by colour what country
is drained by each.

From Dec 1-May the Rains and water rise. Begin
to fall about June 21. Difference is 40 feet.

Gaps... flooded lands.

Temp from 75 to 90.

Thunderstorms from 4 to 6.

Amazon forest extends 2600 to 1000 miles

Solemn grandeur not brilliancy prevails.

Flowers are quickly deciduous.

September good month - no rain.

Hot days with north wind but most oppressive with South.

No real seasons.

2740 miles long.

Rise is 8 inches in a mile.

20 miles wide at many points

Campes... plains.

Pervading wind is SE and a boat may go under sail to the frontier.
