MOTORISTS!

Read and carefully observe the following points regarding Permits and Licenses:—

1. Operators' licenses and chauffeurs' licenses are required by law to be in the possession of the operator whenever driving a motor vehicle.
2. Such licenses are not valid until signed by the operator or chauffeur.
3. They should be carefully preserved as they are required when application is made for renewal.
4. Application for transfer of a motor vehicle permit must be made on the form of application provided on the back of the permit and must be accompanied by the fee of \$2.00.
5. Motor vehicle permits should be carefully preserved as they are required when touring and useful when making application for new permits.
6. Duplicates of motor vehicle permits, chauffeurs' or operators' licenses may be procured on payment of the fee of 50¢ in the event of the original being lost.

MOTOR VEHICLE PERMIT AND OPERATOR'S LICENSE HOLDER

SEVEN RULES FOR SAFETY

1. Have your car in perfect mechanical shape — particularly lights, brakes and steering gear.
2. In passing traffic, be sure the road ahead is clear. Look and listen at railway crossings.
3. When other cars try to pass you — let them pass.
4. On curves — at intersections — going over the tops of hills — keep to the right. Don't try to pass another vehicle. In entering main highways, stop and look.
5. Don't loaf where traffic is heavy.
6. Don't stop on the Highway — pull off to one side.
7. Always signal before you slow down, stop or change your course.

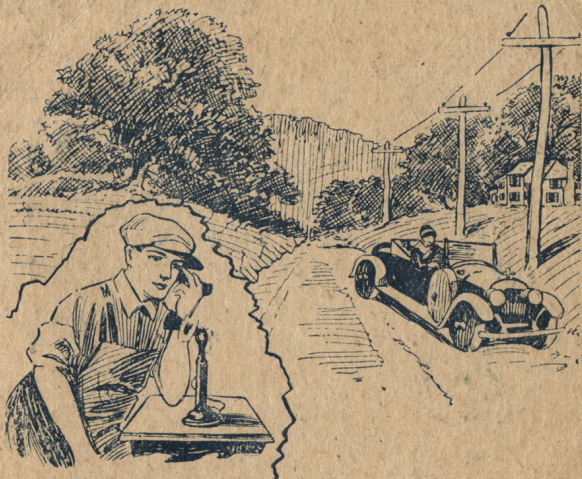
