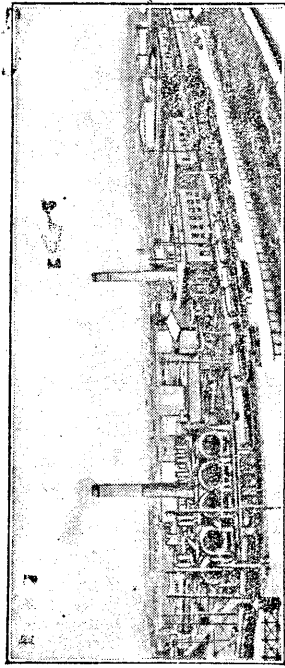

Post Cards—Canada, British Empire, France, North and South American Continents 2c. Other countries 3c.

Letters—Local or drop letters 2c. first oz. 1c. each additional oz. or fraction thereof. North America, Central and South America, the British Empire, France, Spain and Palestine 3c. first oz. 2c. each additional oz. or fraction thereof. Other countries 5c. for first oz. and 3c. for each additional oz. or fraction thereof.

Registered Letters—Canada, and all countries in the postal Union, 10c. in addition to ordinary postage.

Newspapers and Periodicals—All newspapers and periodicals for Canada, U.S.A. and Mexico 1c. per 4 oz. Canadian Newspapers and periodicals for Canada, Great Britain and possessions, 1c. for 4 oz. or fraction thereof. Newspapers other than Canadian except where mentioned above 1c. each 2 oz. or fraction thereof.

Printed Matter—In or outside of Canada 1c. for each 2 oz. or fraction thereof. There are certain limits as to size and weight.

Commercial Papers, Documents, etc.—Canada-letter rate. Other countries-letter rate or in open covers 5c. for first 10 oz. and 1c. for each additional two oz.

Samples—Limit of size to any country 18" x 8" x 4" or if in rolls 18" x 6" limit of weight 1 lb. Rate—Canada, U.S.A., Mexico 1c. for each 2 oz. or fraction thereof. All other countries 2c. for first 4 oz. or fraction thereof, and 1c. for each additional 2 oz. or fraction thereof.

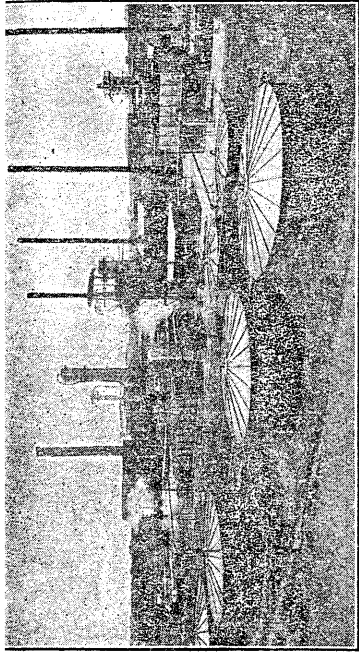
